# Building Safety

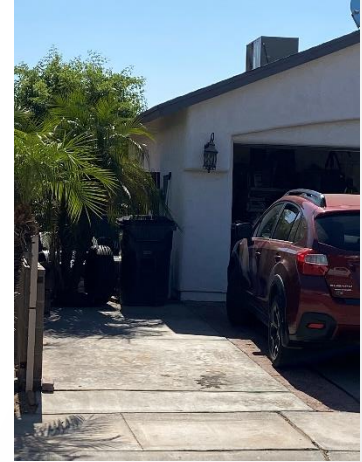
- Building permits: **390**

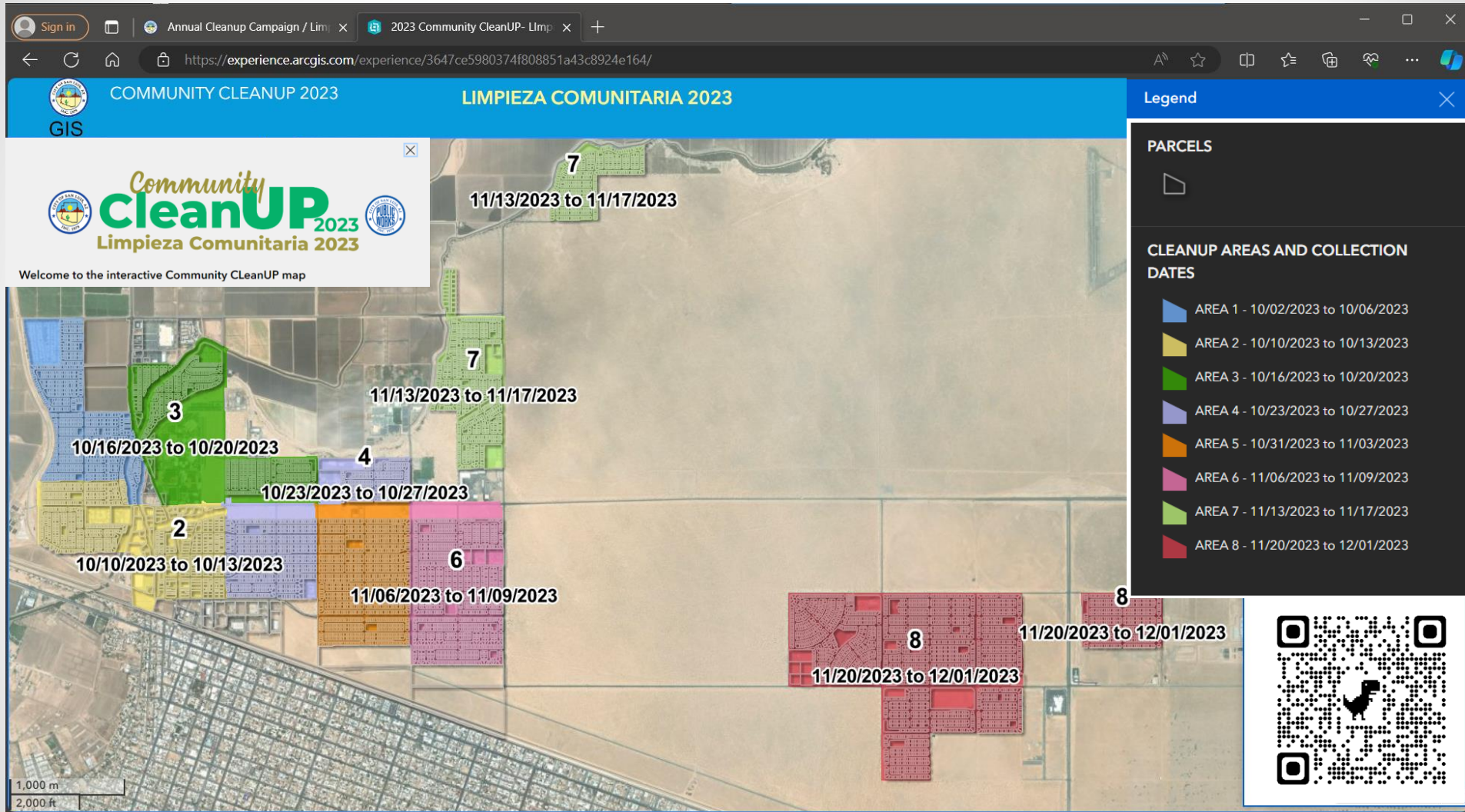
# Code Enforcement

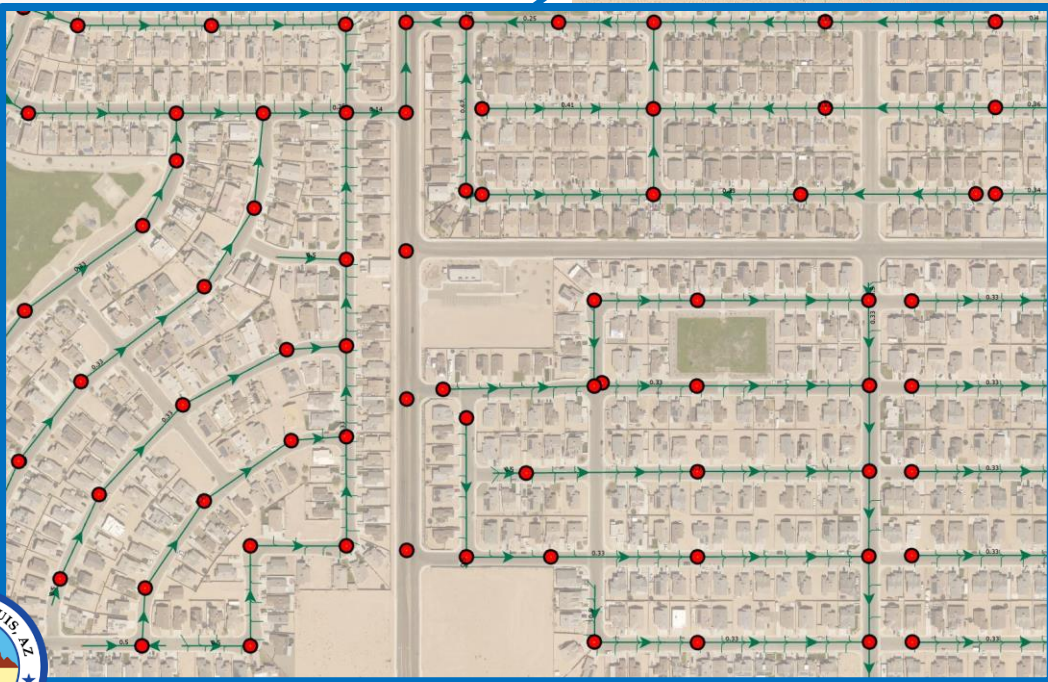
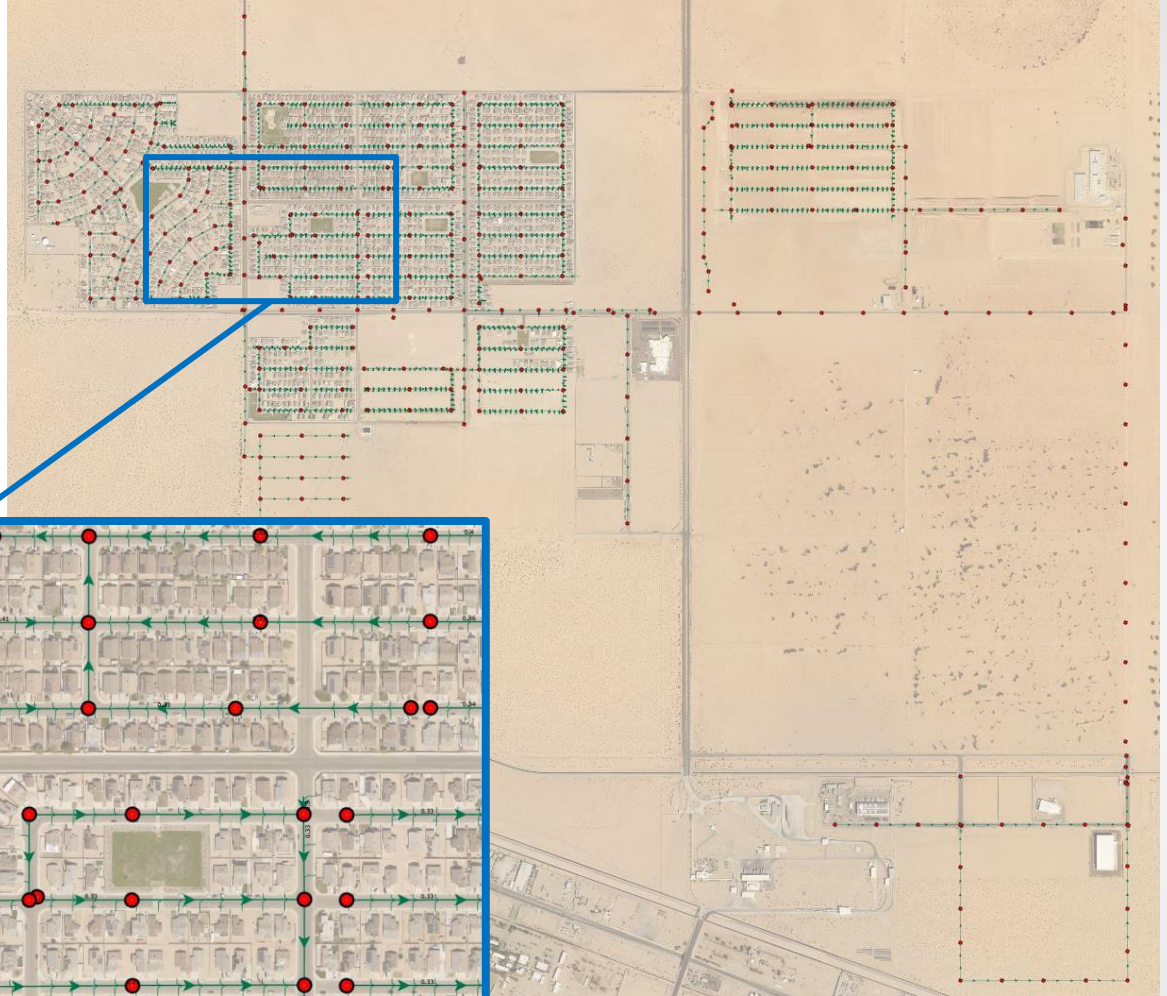
