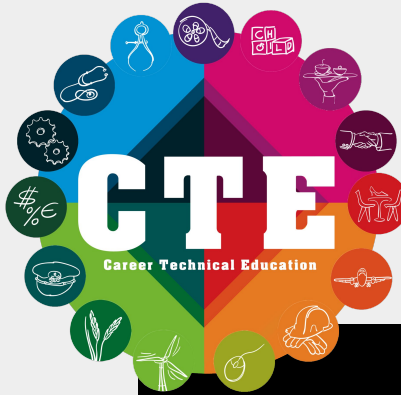

Construction Technology

- Construction technology is a hands on class designed to equip students with the skills and knowledge needed to safely and professionally develop their vocation.
- In the class, students can work in teams to practice their blue-printing, plumbing, electrical skills by hands on practice in construction project development activities such as building small models and creating blueprints.
- Some certifications students can obtain are OSHA-10 and OSHA-30 in Construction Health and Safety , as well as their (Technical Skills assessment) TSA Certification.
- Students can attend many SkillsUSA conferences. They also get to compete in categories such as carpentry, masonry and technical math.



Law & Public Safety

- Law and Public safety is a program where students get the opportunity to learn and develop skill sets related to the Law Enforcement Field. Each student gets to experience the pride of protection and serving the community. We apply forensic investigative skills to process crime scenes. As Well as the performance of Law enforcement operations such as SWAT techniques, calls for service, traffic control, police car maneuvers and everything about Gun Safety.

- Level 1 focuses on the history of law enforcement. The fundamentals like Police Alphabet, Police Codes, Radio basics, Gun Safety, and Crime scene Investigations.

- Level 2 Is a more hands-on experience, Students get the opportunity to get certified from various organizations like for example: CPR, CSM, FEMA, OSHA and many more. Students experience educational field trips that enrich the students by showcasing different law enforcement fields. And overall prepare them for a career in this field.

Skills USA

- Law and public safety is part of Skillsusa, an organization whose mission is to “empower students to become skilled professionals, career ready leaders and responsible community members. Through Skillsusa we attend various leadership conferences and competitions that ultimately allow us to showcase our skills and abilities. Skillsusa empowers us to be

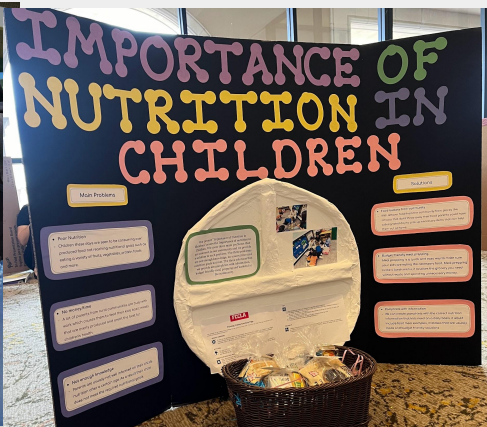




Early Childhood & SLHS Preschool

Film and TV

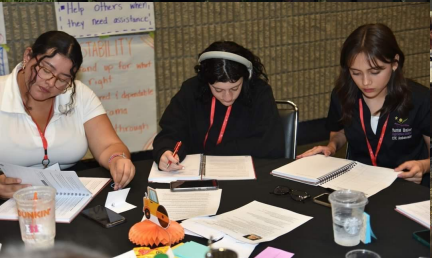


- Be part of a professional broadcast team producing videos for sporting events, news reports, and commercials
