A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FY 2025 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) REGIONAL ACCOUNT FUNDS (RA), CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Arizona, is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG RA requires that CDBG funds requested address one of the three Congressionally mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activity within this application addresses the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low-and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, an Applicant for State CDBG-RA is required to comply with the program guidelines and federal statutes and regulations.

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration requires a resolution of the governing body committing leveraged local funds and a legal opinion confirming the enforceability of that commitment under state law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, County of Yuma, authorize these applications to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY 2025 CDBG- RA funds and authorize the Mayor to sign the application, contract or grant documents for receipt of and use of these funds for the Merrill Avenue Street Improvements Phase II; and authorize the

Mayor to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application; and

THAT, this application for State CDBG funds meets the requirements of low-and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefitting low-and moderate-income persons, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

THAT, the City of San Luis, Arizona will comply with all State CDBG program guidelines, federal statutes, and regulations applicable to the State CDBG-RA and the certifications contained in this application.
