01. **Career**

02. **Technical**

These programs help students explore career interests, build practical skills, and often earn industry certifications or college credits.

03. **Education**

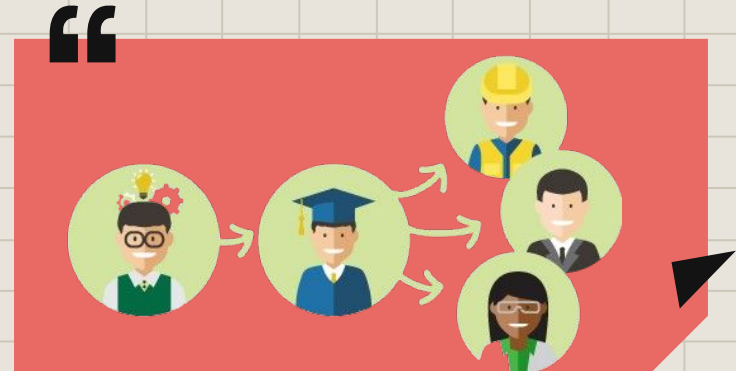

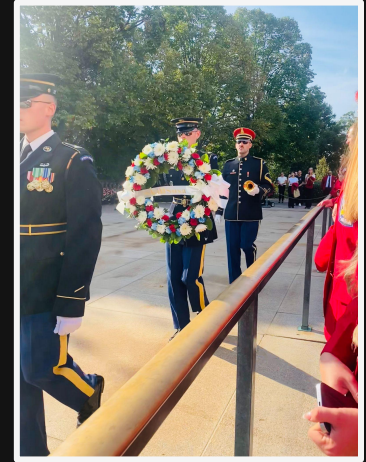
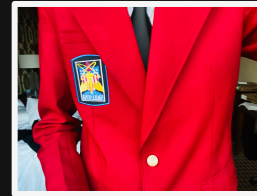

Career and Technical Education gives students the extraordinary opportunity to dream, become, and fulfill. I am eternally grateful for this program and it's remarkable way of empowering students.

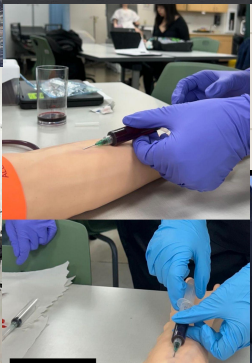

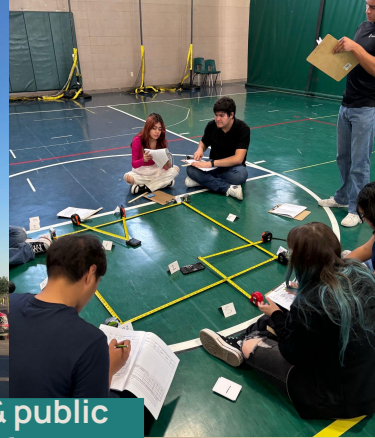
