A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION HERITAGE FUNDS; REPEALING CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, the Legislature under A.R.S. § 41-503 has authorized the establishment of the Historic Preservation Heritage Fund Program providing funds to the State of Arizona and other eligible applicants for the purposes of preserving historic and prehistoric resources; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Parks Board (BOARD) is responsible for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application under the program; and

WHEREAS, said adopted procedures established by the BOARD require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications, signature authorization, the availability of local matching funds, and authorization to sign a Participant Agreement with the BOARD; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project must be consistent with the Arizona Historic Preservation Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona:

Section 1: The Mayor and City Council hereby approve the filing of an application for FY 2026 Historic Preservation Heritage Fund Grant assistance for an eligible historic preservation project.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Council certify that the applicable state and federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements related to the submission, administration, and implementation of the grant application.

Section 3: The City of San Luis agrees to comply with all procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by the Arizona State Parks & Trails Board as part of the application and award process.

Section 4: The City of San Luis commits a matching contribution in the amount of \$36,000.00.

Section 5: The Mayor and City Council hereby appoint, Director of Economic Development, Armando Esparza, and any additional designated representatives, as authorized agents of the City of San Luis to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents necessary for the completion of the project, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and billing statements.
