The following is a bid results summary and recommendation for the COSL LS 300 Influent Sewer Force Main – 2025-050.

### 1.1 Bid Process Summary

The bid process included the following major milestones:

1. The public notice inviting bids were published on QuestCDN #9989354 and in the *Yuma Sun* on December 21, 2025, and December 28, 2025.
2. A mandatory pre-bid conference was held January 6, 2025, at 10:00 AM at COSL City Hall Pedro Conference Room. Eleven (11) contractors attended the pre-bid conference; attendees were in person and virtual via Teams.
3. Bids were received by the City Clerk at City Hall January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2026, by 3:00PM. Out of the eleven prime bidder plan holders, five bids were received with bid offerings as follows:

a. Taylor Engineering, PLLC	\$2,534,777.00	
b. Yuma Valley Contractors	\$1,627,560.17	Apparent Low Bidder
c. Gutierrez Canales Engineering, PC	\$2,132,365.98	
d. Meridian Engineering Company	\$2,466,413.25	
e. DPE Construction Inc	\$1,638,000.00	
4. The Engineers Estimate of Probable Cost is \$1,592,950.19. The apparent low bidder was Yuma Valley Contractors, with a bid price of \$1,627,560.17 that includes a scope of work bid of \$1,550,057.30 with an additional 5% contingency of \$77,502.87. The apparent low bid price is within 2.2% of the engineers' estimate. Bid Tabulation and Yuma Valley Contractor's bid are enclosed for your reference.
5. The funding for this project is, in part, coming from a WIFA, which requires all Bidders to included Davis Bacon wage rates, American Iron & Steel (AIS) requirements.

### 1.2 Analysis of Contractor's Ability

The apparent low bid contractor, Yuma Valley Contractors, has been in the Yuma/San Luis area for many years, with tremendous experience in pipeline projects. Overall, we believe that Yuma Valley Contractors would be a very capable contractor for the project.

### 1.3 Valid Contractor's License Verification

A search on AZROC.gov was performed and Yuma Valley Contractors has the A-General Engineering License #106548 that is active with no complaints on file, the License Verification is enclosed for reference.

### 1.4 Engineer's Recommendation

PACE is recommending to the City of San Luis Award this contract to Yuma Valley Contractors, the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$1,627,560.17, which includes a 5% contingency.



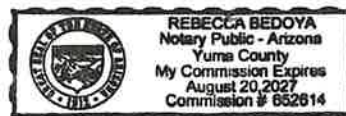
