**AN ORDER OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE REMNANT DEFENDANT OPIOID SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT DATED FEBRUARY 23, 2026.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis received notice of eligibility to participate in the Remnant Defendant Opioid Settlement Agreement on March 5, 2026

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis desires to join the Remnant Defendant Opioid Settlement Agreement (dated February 23, 2026)

**WHEREAS**, participants in the Remnant Defendant Opioid Settlement Agreement must opt-in before May 4, 2026.

**WHEREAS**, the San Luis City Council finds it in the public interest for the City to join the settlement for the benefits provided from the abatement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona:

**SECTION 1:** The above-recited understanding and findings of the San Luis City Council are incorporated by this reference and made a part of this order.

**SECTION 2:** The Mayor is authorized to sign the opt-in form to join the Remnant Defendant Opioid Settlement Agreement.

**SECTION 3:** The City Manager and City Attorney or their designees are authorized to take such action as is necessary to join the Remnant Defendant Opioid Settlement Agreement.
