

RESOLUTION NO. 22-R-25

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCHERTZ, TEXAS APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SCHERTZ, TEXAS AND GUADALUPE COUNTY, TEXAS FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF ECKHARDT ROAD/GREEN VALLEY ROAD, AND OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, The City staff of the City of Schertz (the “City”) recommends that the Mayor and Council approve the InterLocal Agreement (ILA) between the City of Schertz and Guadalupe County for said roadwork; and

WHEREAS, The City of Schertz will provide the funding for the materials and Guadalupe County will provide labor and equipment for the said roadwork;

WHEREAS, The roadways will be completed this spring and improve travel for drivers by providing a smoother and safer roadway surface;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCHERTZ, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute and deliver the Inter-Local Agreement with Guadalupe County.

Section 2. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the City Council.

Section 3. All resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America

Section 5. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the City Council hereby declares that this Resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

Section 6. It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.

Section 7. This Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its final passage, and it is so resolved.
