

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-R-37**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCHERTZ, TEXAS, SETTING THE FIRST MONDAY ON OR AFTER THE FIRST DAY OF SPRING EACH YEAR AS “EMPLOYEE REMEMBRANCE DAY”, HONORING DECEASED EMPLOYEES WHO SERVED 10 YEARS OR MORE, AS WELL AS THOSE WHO PASSED AWAY WHILE ACTIVELY EMPLOYED BY THE CITY.**

**WHEREAS**, a monument was erected at 10 Commercial Place in 1996, constructed by fellow City employees, to honor the following employees for their years of dedicated service;

The City of Schertz flag will be flown at half-staff on all City flagpoles in memory of all dedicated city employees who served the citizens of Schertz, Texas, with pride and professionalism.
