The SHSP Grant Program is administered by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

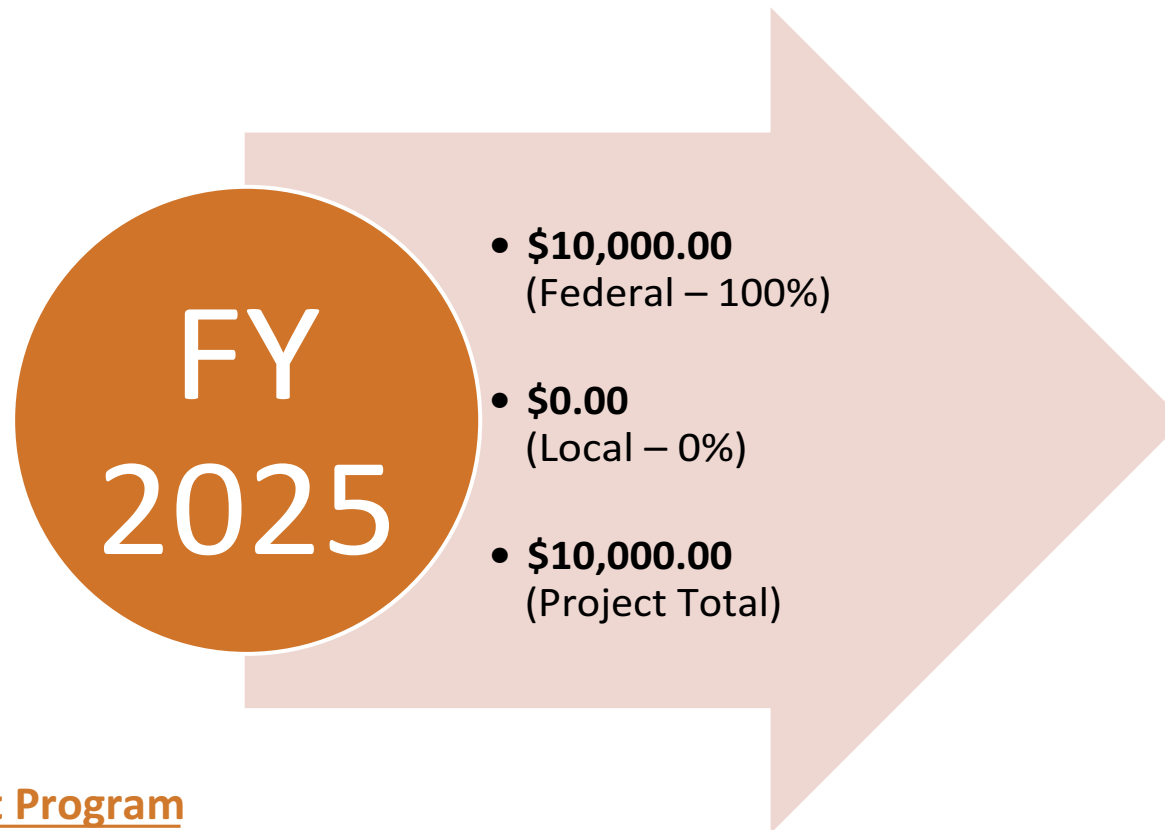
- Managed by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM), Office of the Governor (OOG), and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

Designed to build, sustain, and enhance capabilities to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other hazards. This includes investments in areas such as:

- Addressing High-Priority Preparedness Gaps, support for the Texas Homeland Security Strategic Plan, national priority areas, law enforcement terrorism prevention activities, whole community approach activities, and funding for preparedness activities.

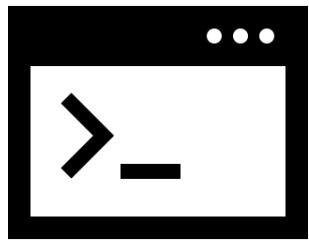
SHSP serves as a critical mechanism to bolster local defense against terrorism and other significant threats, fostering a more secure and resilient nation.
