LHMPP GRANT PROGRAM SUMMARY

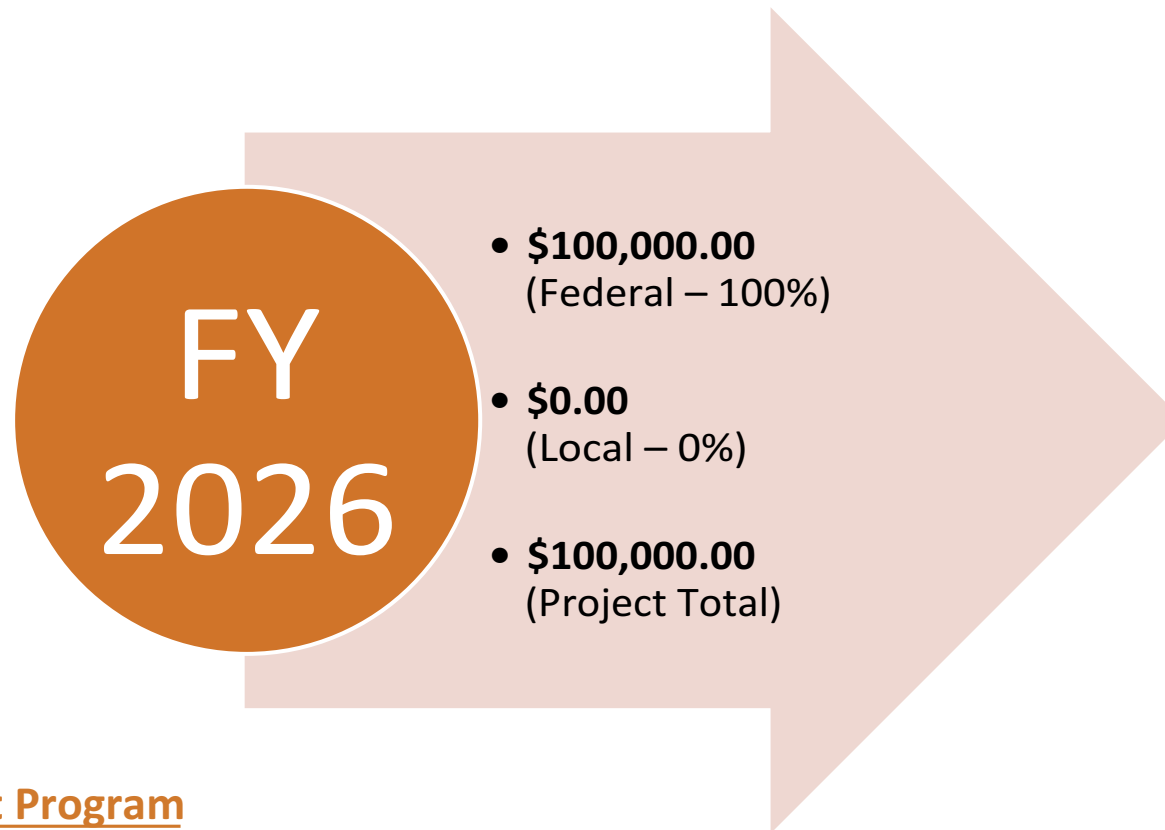
The LHMPP is administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)

- Managed by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) and Texas General Land Office (GLO).

Designed to provide local governments with the framework and often the funding to proactively identify, assess, and reduce long-term risks from natural and human – caused hazards. This includes investments in areas such as:

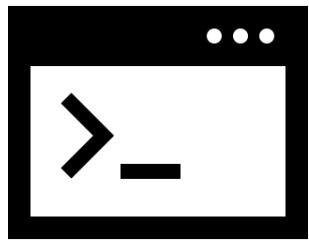
- Comprehensive Planning Process
