HMGP GRANT PROGRAM SUMMARY

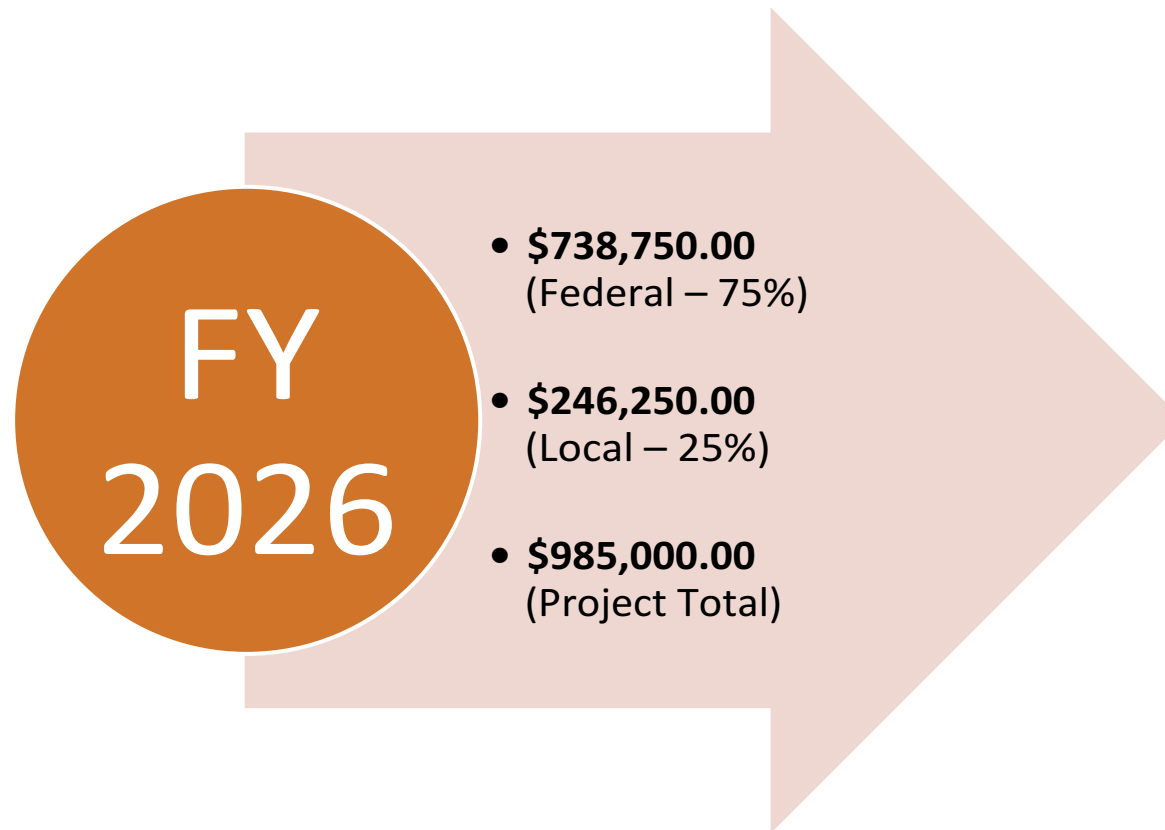
The HMGP is administered by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

- Managed by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

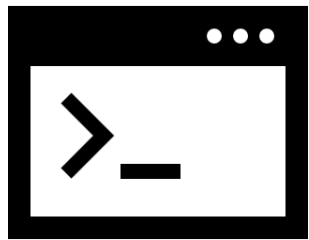
Designed to implement long-term hazard mitigation measures after a major disaster declaration. This includes investments in areas such as:
