PLANNING BOARD MINUTES February 3, 2025

The Planning Board of the City of Texas City met in a regular meeting on Monday, February 3, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. Staff members present: Kimberly Golden, P.E. (City Engineer, Secretary), Casey Bennet (Chief Building Official), David Kinchen (Deputy Building Official), Curt Kelly (Engineering & Planning Administrator), Veronica Carreon (Planning & Zoning Technician), and Brianna Galicia (Engineering & Planning Administrative Assistant). Guests were: Daniel Ortiz, CW Scheibe, Chris Green, Ian Stewart, and Henry Gomez.

Chairman Dickey Campbell indicated a quorum was present and called the meeting to order.

1) ROLL CALL

The following members answered roll call: Chairman Dickey Campbell, Co-Chairman Perry O'Brien, Member Aric Owens, Commissioner Thelma Bowie, and Commissioner Jami Clark.

2) APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion to approve the minutes of January 13, 2025, was made by Commissioner Thelma Bowie/ Commissioner Jami Clark. All other members present voted aye.

3) PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

4) REGULAR AGENDA

a. Consider and take action on the Development Plan for the TCISD Dance Studio Addition & Culinary Renovation. Located at 1431 9th Avenue North at the southwest corner of the existing Texas City High School.

Ms. Golden introduced the Texas City ISD project as the 4,680 sft addition of a Dance Studio and the renovation of 3,133 sqft for the Culinary Arts area. Ms. Golden stated the project is adding 4,680 sqft addition to the southwest corner of the existing Texas City High School. She stated the plan has been reviewed and is compliant with everything and that there is no significant impact to drainage, traffic flow, or circulation. She referenced the Fire Marshal's written comment that it must be ensured that all fire protection and life safety devices cover this area, which comment will be addressed during the process of plan review for the building permit. Ms. Golden stated there was no objection to approval of the Development Plan as submitted.

Member Aric Owens questioned if there was going to be a locker room available for the children in which Mr. Chris Green (Architect) replied yes, there will be one available for use.

A motion was made by Co-Chairman Perry O'Brien/Commissioner Jami Clark to approve the Development Plan for the TCISD Dance Studio Addition & Culinary

Renovation. Located at 1431 9th Avenue North at the southwest corner of the existing Texas City High School. All other members voted aye.

b. Consider and take action on the Development Plan for the TCISD New Ag Barn. Located at 3301 25th Avenue North – south of the Texas City Biosphere.

Ms. Golden noted the diversity of opportunities TCISD has for its students from dancing to culinary arts to hands on experience with livestock management. Texas City currently has an existing agricultural education facility that sits on 1.10 acres and is located behind, south of the Texas City Biosphere. She stated TCISD has a project to demolish the existing barn and construct a new 17,680 sq ft facility. According to the signage it indicates the barn will be used for cattle and pig. This project also has plans to renovate the existing parking lot including restriping and adding wheel stops.

Ms. Golden informed all that if this were to be anybody else's barn it most likely wouldn't be compliant with the zoning district, but because it is part of the school district and being operated as a public education facility it fits in the current zoning in District A – Single Family Residential. She stated there are no records of any complaints regarding the use of the existing facility for educational purposes. She noted the location behind the City's Biosphere is a good place for the barn and for the Biosphere. Ms. Golden stated staff have no objection to approval of the Development Plan as submitted.

Commissioner Thelma Bowie questioned if it was strictly just cattle and pig or if any other animals would be located at the facility. Co-Chairman O'Brien stated that was going to be his question as well. CW Scheibe replied there will be other small animals possibly goats and chickens. The picture of only the cattle and pigs were just for the sake of the graphics. Chairman Campbell asked if they installed the automatic sprayer for pests & bugs, he believes it could be a waste of money. Commissioner Jami Clark asked why it is a waste of money and Chairman Campbell replied because no matter if you spray, since it is livestock, the pest & bugs will be attracted to areas as such. Mr. Scheibe replied yes, it was a requirement that they install it and believe it cost under \$100,000 because it was not a super complex system.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jami Clark/Commissioner Thelma Bowie to approve the Development Plan for the TCISD New Ag Barn. Located at 3301 25th Avenue North – south of the Texas City Biosphere. All other members present voted aye.

 Consider and take action on the Development Plan for College of the Mainland PSC Training Tower. Located at 1200 N. Amburn Road in Texas City.

Ms. Golden reminded the Board that the Board had previously considered and approved an overall site plan for the College of the Mainland bond projects and had also approved a joint development plan for the Public Safety Center (PSC) and Continuing & Corporate Education Center (CCEC). She stated that building permits have been issued for both the PSC and CCEC and construction is in progress. The PSC Training Tower was excluded from those previous applications and approvals so the PSC could receive expedited review and approval.

Ms. Golden stated the PSC Training tower is 470 sq ft facility to be located at the southeast corner of the COM Campus. This facility consists of five floors of mostly open staircases for student mobility and endurance training to simulate real word rescue scenarios. She informed all that this is only a training tower and not a fire tower. This facility will not be operated with fire, smoke, or other noxious fumes or conditions. She also mentioned that Public Works has discussed with COM's engineers and project team the possibility the import of fill may create on site ponding due to the presence of an existing swale. It is understood COM will address this potential issue with the building officials and Public Works during the building permitting review and inspections process.

Ms. Golden stated upon the condition of the training tower not being operated with fire, smoke, or other noxious fumes and that COM will resolve any on-site ponding issues caused by importing fill to the site, the staff have no objection to approval of the development plan for the PSC Training Tower. Co-Chairman O'Brien stated he is in full support of training and safety but wanted to know what specific training will be done at the facility. Daniel Ortiz replied there will be physical fitness training going up and down the towers with their gear, floor breakouts, rope training to learn how to propel off the towers, and hose training to ensure nothing gets tangled up.

Chairman Campbell asked if this is something our local fire department can have access to or is it strictly for the fire academy. Mr. Scheibe stated it is currently only for the fire academy but has no doubt that Dr. Nicholes would be open to making arrangements for local fire departments to use the facility if requested and if available.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jami Clark/ Commissioner Thelma Bowie to approve the Development Plan for College of the Mainland PSC Training Tower upon the condition of the training tower not being operated with fire, smoke, or other noxious fumes and that COM will resolve any on-site ponding issues caused by importing fill to the site. Located at 1200 N. Amburn Road in Texas City. All other members present voted aye.

d. Consider and approve a revision to the Final Plat for Lago Mar Pod 9 Section 2 to change the name of Beacon Shore Lane to Ocean Ritz Lane.

Ms. Golden stated Lago Mar Pod 9 Section 2 is part of a master-planned Lago Mar residential development that will ultimately contain approximately 4,000 lots. Pod 9 Section 2 subdivided 58.50 acres into 200 residential lots of 55 sq ft and 60 sq ft widths. The final plat of Pod 9, Section 2 received approval from the Planning Board on December 5, 2022 and is now nearing completion of construction of the infrastructure. During the closeout process Ms. Golden stated that it came to attention that the naming of a street as Beacon Shore Lane could create confusion due to the Beacon Point at Lago Mar Subdivision being located on the east side of I45. Pod 9 Section 2 is located at the far northwest quadrant the residential section of Lago Mar. Ms. Golden said there was concern of this creating confusion for first responders, delivery services, and the U.S. Postal Services.

Ms. Golden said staff recommended changing the proposed name of the street from Beacon Shore Lane to something else. The developer proposed Ocean Ritz Lane which name was reviewed and found not to conflict with any other existing street name. Ms

Golden stated there would be no change to the number or arrangement of the lots, only to the name of the street on the plat when recorded. Chairman Campbell questioned how they are changing the name if the street is already there. Ms. Golden replied because the plat has not been recorded the change can be made with minimal impact or confusion because no building permits have been issued for this section. She also stated it is easier to fix now while no permits have been issued rather than coming back with an amending plat which would be more complicated.

A motion was made by Commissioner Thelma Bowie/Commissioner Jami Clark to approve changing the name of Beacon Shore Lane to Ocean Ritz Lane on the Final Plat for Lago Mar Pod 9 Section 2 before it was recorded. All other members presented voted aye.

5) GENERAL UPDATES

Ms. Golden brought to everyone's attention that they now have a copy of the 2025 meeting schedule in their binders and that Veronica will be emailing them a copy, too.

6) OTHER BUSINESS (Any conceptual development proposal requesting to come before the Planning Board)

Re: Beacon Point at Lago Mar Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 - Preliminary Plats

Beacon Point at Lago Mar is part of a master-planned residential development that will ultimately contain approximately 4,000 lots. It is the first master plan approved in the Lago Mar PUD on the east side of Gulf Freeway (I-45). A revised Master Plan for the remaining portions of Lago Mar residential was approved by the City on August 19, 2020. The master plan for Beacon Point at Lago Mar was approved by the Planning Board on December 5, 2022, and by the City Commission on December 7, 2022. Preliminary Plats for Sections 1, 2 and 3 were approved by the Planning Board on April 4, 2023. The Final Plats for Sections 1 and 2 were approved on September 18, 2023, and for Section 3 on August 5, 2024. Infrastructure construction is nearing completion for all three sections and in the close-out process. Due to the timely submittal and completion of plats, the Master Plan for Beacon Point at Lago Mar remains valid.

Beacon Point is a shift in development to the east side of the Gulf Freeway (I-45), but still within the Lago Mar PUD. The lots will be subject to the same HOA which operates for Lago Mar on the west side of the Gulf Freeway.

Although Beacon Point at Lago Mar is located within the approved Lago Mar PUD, the developer is not Land Tejas. Through assignment, the developer of Beacon Point at Lago Mar is Affinity Lago Clara, LLC, which has common majority ownership with Chessmark Homes, a builder-developer. The companies operate independently. Quiddity Engineering (f/k/a Jones & Carter) continues to serve as the design engineers which provides for continuity in the design and construction of the infrastructure systems.

The development lies within the boundaries of the GCMUD No. 57. The Utility Service Agreement was approved by the City Commission on February 7, 2024.

Requested Action: The applicant is requesting Preliminary Plat approval for Phase II which consists of four (4) sections as follows:

Approval of the Preliminary Plat authorizes the developer to prepare the final construction drawings for the public infrastructure along with submitting the Final Plat for this phase of the project.

Staff Review/Analysis: The Preliminary Plat is intended to be an opportunity to review the lot configuration, utility layout, and street patterns. Preliminary one-line drawings showing the locations of utility lines, drainage and detention features, and the street patterns, have been submitted for review and approved.

Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 will develop 278 single-family residential lots in Phase II of the Beacon Point at Lago Mar subdivision with a lot size mix as indicated in the following table. The table below summarizes the lot mix to date for Phases I and II when considered together and shows a balance in the development of a variety of lot sizes.

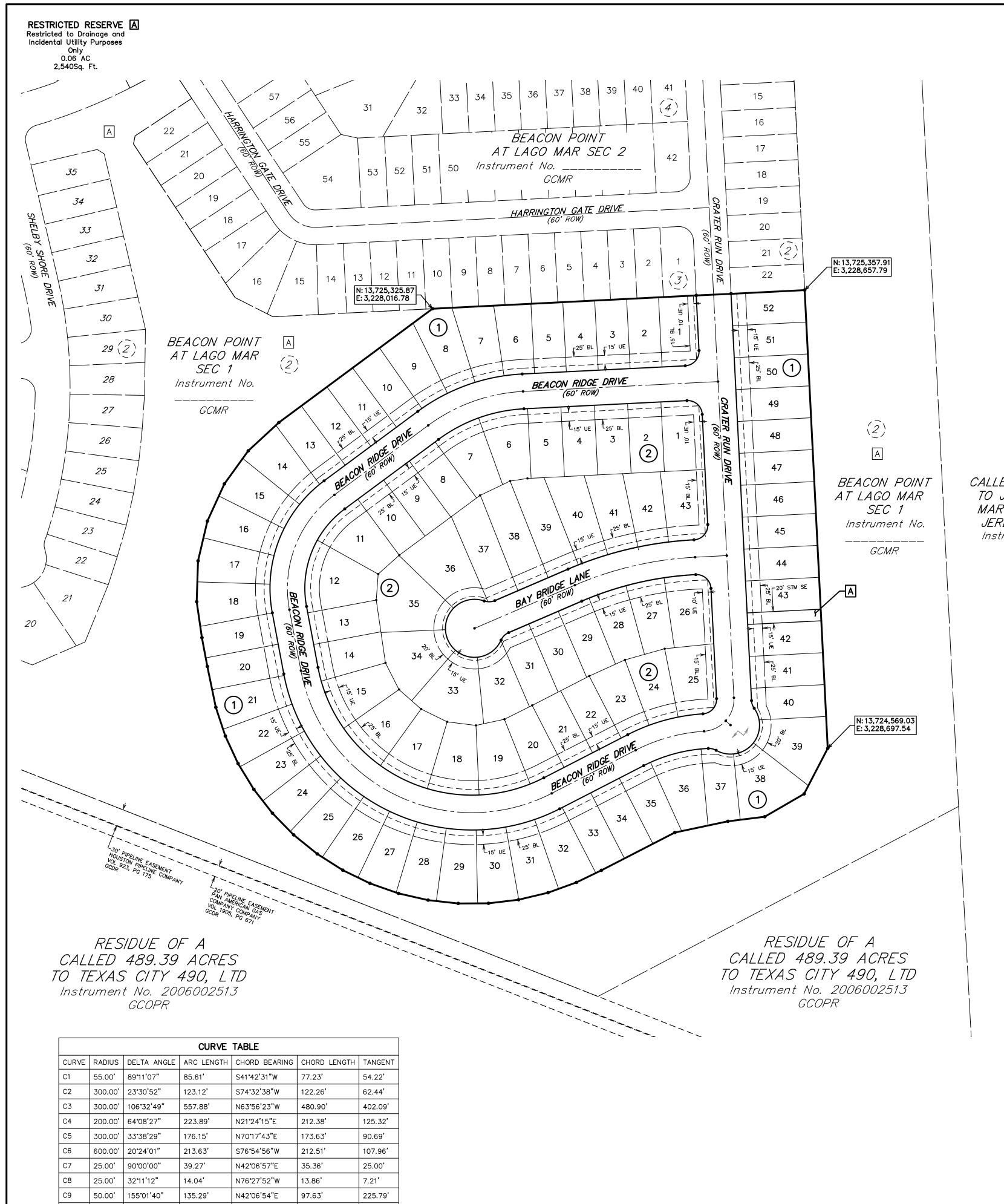

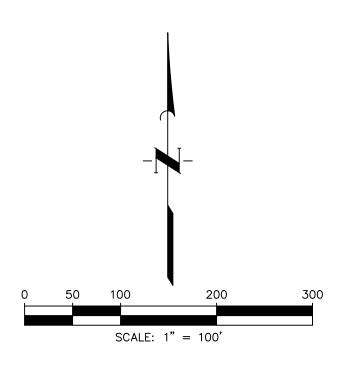
Roadway access from the northbound frontage road was constructed in Phase I. A second access from the extension of Holland Rd will be developed in Phase II.

Water and sewer facilities were extended to the subdivision in Phase I with a 16-in watermain along the I-45 frontage road, and the addition of a sanitary sewer lift station and force main which connects with Lift Station 29. Water mains of 12 and 8 inches will be extended throughout the subdivision with Phase II together with gravity mains.

Section 3 in Phase I includes a 3.77-acre reserve for recreational use. Concept plans for the building out of the recreational facilities have been received and are in review. Construction of the park facilities is expected to begin during the construction of Phase II.

The Preliminary Plat should follow the master plan with regard to arrangement of lots, layout and alignment of streets, parks, and open spaces. The Preliminary Plats for Beacon Point at Lago Mar Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 do this. **Staff have reviewed the Preliminary Plat with all the supporting documents and recommends approval upon condition that the four sections, 4, 5, 6 and 7 be developed together to assure balanced development and build out of the various sized lots in accordance with the requirements of the PUD.**

Re: Nicolet Bend Drive - Preliminary Plat

Background: Nicolet Bend Drive is a second point of access for Phase II of Beacon Point at Lago Mar. The first point of access, Beacon Point Blvd, connects to the northbound frontage road of the Gulf Freeway (I-45) and was constructed as part of Phase I. Beacon Point Blvd will be accepted during closeout of Phase I. Phase I developed 243 lots. Phase II will develop a total of 317 more lots for a total of 560 developed lots when Phase II is fully platted. This number of lots requires an independent, second point of access. Nicolet Bend Drive is that second point of access.

Preliminary Plats for Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 of Beacon Point at Lago Mar are being presented to the Planning Board contemporaneously with the Preliminary Plat for Nicolet Bend Dr. The Preliminary Plat for Section 3B (renamed Section 9) which is developing 39 lots in Phase II was previously approved by the Planning Board on December 2, 2024.

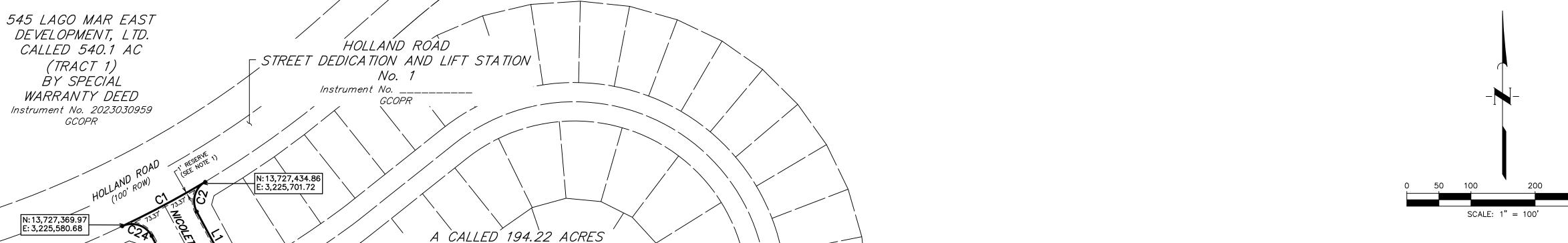
Requested Action: The applicant is requesting Preliminary Plat approval for an 80ft right of way and 2.92 acres to develop the approximate 1500 feet connection of Nicolet Bend Drive to Holland Rd. Approval of the Preliminary Plat authorizes the developer to prepare the final construction drawings for the public infrastructure along with submitting the Final Plat for this section of the project.

Staff Review/Analysis: The Preliminary Plat is intended to be an opportunity to review the lot configuration, utility layout, and street patterns. Preliminary one-line drawings showing the locations of utility lines, drainage and detention features, and the street patterns, have been submitted for review and approved. In addition to the extension of the street, extension of the 12-inch water main, 12-inch sanitary sewer gravity main and 24-inch storm sewer will be included in the construction project.

The Preliminary Plat and one-lines for the Holland Rd extension have been reviewed and comments returned to the developer. A resubmittal is expected soon. Completion, inspection, testing and acceptance of Nicolet Bend Drive and the

extension of Holland Rd will be conditions for the recording of the final plats for Beacon Point at Lago Mar Sections 4, 5, 6, 7 and 9.

The Preliminary Plat should follow the Master Plan with regard to arrangement of lots, layout and alignment of streets, parks, and open spaces. The Preliminary Plat for Nicolet Bend Drive does this. Staff have reviewed the Preliminary Plat with all the supporting documents and offer no objections to approval.
