

**Position Title:**  
**Peace Officer – Special Events Security (Part-Time/Seasonal)**

**Job Summary:**

Peace officers working at special events, receptions, concerts, and festivals are responsible for maintaining public safety, enforcing laws and regulations, and ensuring a secure environment for attendees, vendors, and event staff. This role requires vigilance, strong communication skills, and the ability to act quickly and appropriately in dynamic situations.

**Major Duties:**

- 1. Event Security and Crowd Control:**
  - Monitor entry and exit points to prevent unauthorized access.
  - Conduct bag checks or security screenings, as required.
  - Manage crowd movement to ensure safe ingress, egress, and flow within event areas.
  - Respond to disturbances, de-escalate conflicts, and address disorderly behavior.
