

Amendment 1
To the Third Party Funding Agreement FY 2025
between
WEBB COUNTY
and
Laredo Regional Food Bank, Inc.

The original contract, dated October 15th, 2024 by and between Webb County, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, (hereinafter called "COUNTY") and Laredo Regional Food Bank, Inc., a 501(c)(3), non-profit corporation (hereinafter called "LRFB"), is hereby amended in the following respects:

Paragraph 1: The amended Exhibit A will reflect the reallocation of a portion of the awarded funds in the amount of \$5,800.00 (Five Thousand Eight Hundred and NO/100 Dollars) for the purchase of a freezer compressor replacement.

Paragraph 2: The parties agree that the foregoing amendment shall be hereinafter considered a part of the contract referred to above and incorporated by reference therein for all purposes. The amendments shall be subject to any and all other provisions of the contract which are hereby ratified by the parties and remain in full force and effect, with the exception of the parts or provisions of the contract which have been modified by this amendment or prior amendments.

This Agreement becomes effective when signed by the last party whose signing makes the Agreement fully executed.
