**Final Distribution – Convenience Class Unsecured Claims**

Dear Creditor:

As you may be aware, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the “Bankruptcy Court”) confirmed the *Amended Joint Plan of Liquidation Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code of Entrust Energy, Inc. and Its Debtor Affiliates* (as confirmed, the “Plan”)<sup>2</sup> to administer the Entrust Liquidating Trust (the “Trust”). The Plan was confirmed by order of the Bankruptcy Court that became effective on January 6, 2022, on which date the Trust was established.

The Trust hereby encloses a distribution check representing a final distribution from the Trust on account of the Allowed amount of your Convenience Class Unsecured Claim. Under the terms of the Plan, each holder of a Convenience Class Unsecured Claim receives a recovery of **90%** of the Allowed amount of such Claim. No further distributions from the Trust should be expected.

To avoid forfeiture of your distribution and disallowance of your Claim, **please cash your check promptly.** Pursuant to the Plan and its ancillary documents, any distribution check not negotiated within **90 days** after the date a distribution is made is deemed an unclaimed distribution under the Plan. Such unclaimed distribution(s) eventually will revert to the Trust in accordance with the terms of the Plan for all purposes, including, but not limited to, distribution to other holders of Allowed Claims. Additionally, the underlying Claim will no longer be deemed to be Allowed, and the Holder will not be entitled to participate in any other distributions under the Plan in connection with such Claim.

If you have questions about the legal or tax aspects of the distribution, please contact your legal or tax advisors. Neither the Trustee nor its attorneys or other advisors may advise you about the effect of the enclosed distribution on your rights and obligations.

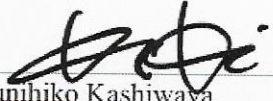
