1848 Generator Relocation and Installation

Project Overview:

This scope of work details the tasks and materials required for the relocation and installation of a 350 kW generator and its associated equipment. The project includes site preparation, concrete foundation work, trenching, electrical conduit and wiring installation, as well as, generator transport and final equipment setup. The project will adhere to all applicable local and national electrical codes and safety standards.

Location: 7128 E Saunders St, Laredo, TX 78043, 111 Camino Nuevo, Laredo, TX 78043

Submitted by: Guillermo B. Cuellar, P.E. Prepared by: Matthew Martin, E.I.T.

1. Site Preparation and Demolition

- **Pad preparation:** Remove and level 102 sq ft of soil from the designated area for trenching and foundation work to ensure a level surface for generator pad construction. This soil will be reinstalled upon project completion to restore the site.
- **Trenching:** Excavate a 50-foot trench, 4-6 inches wide and 30 inches deep. The trench will be used for the direct-buried electrical conduit. The excavated soil will be used for backfill.
- **Service Demolition:** De-energize and remove the existing 277/480 volt, 200 amp double electrical service.

2. Concrete Foundation Work

- **Foundation Formwork:** Construct a formwork for a new 17 ft x 6 ft x 8 in thick generator concrete slab.
- **Reinforcement:** Install #5 steel rebar at 12" o.c. within the formwork to reinforce the concrete slab.
- **Concrete Pour:** Pour and finish 102 sq ft of 8-inch thick 3000 psi concrete to create the new generator foundation slab.
- **Grounding:** Install one 5/8" x 8' copper ground rod and one 5/8" ground rod clamp for the grounding system of the new generator foundation.

3. Generator Transport and Installation

- Loading and Transport:
 - Securely load the 350 kW generator onto heavy-duty transport vehicle at its current location: 111 Camino Nuevo, Laredo, TX 78043.
 - Transport the generator approximately 11 miles to the new project site: 7128 E Saunders St, Laredo, TX 78043.
 - Unload the generator from the transport vehicle and stage it for installation.
- Equipment Installation:
 - Install existing 350 kW generator on the new concrete slab.

- Furnish and install one 400A automatic transfer switch (ATS).
- Furnish and install two 200A, 3-phase, 600V, NEMA 3R, right-hand, fused heavy-duty safety switches.
- Furnish and install two 200A, 1-gang, 3-phase meter sockets.

4. Electrical System Installation

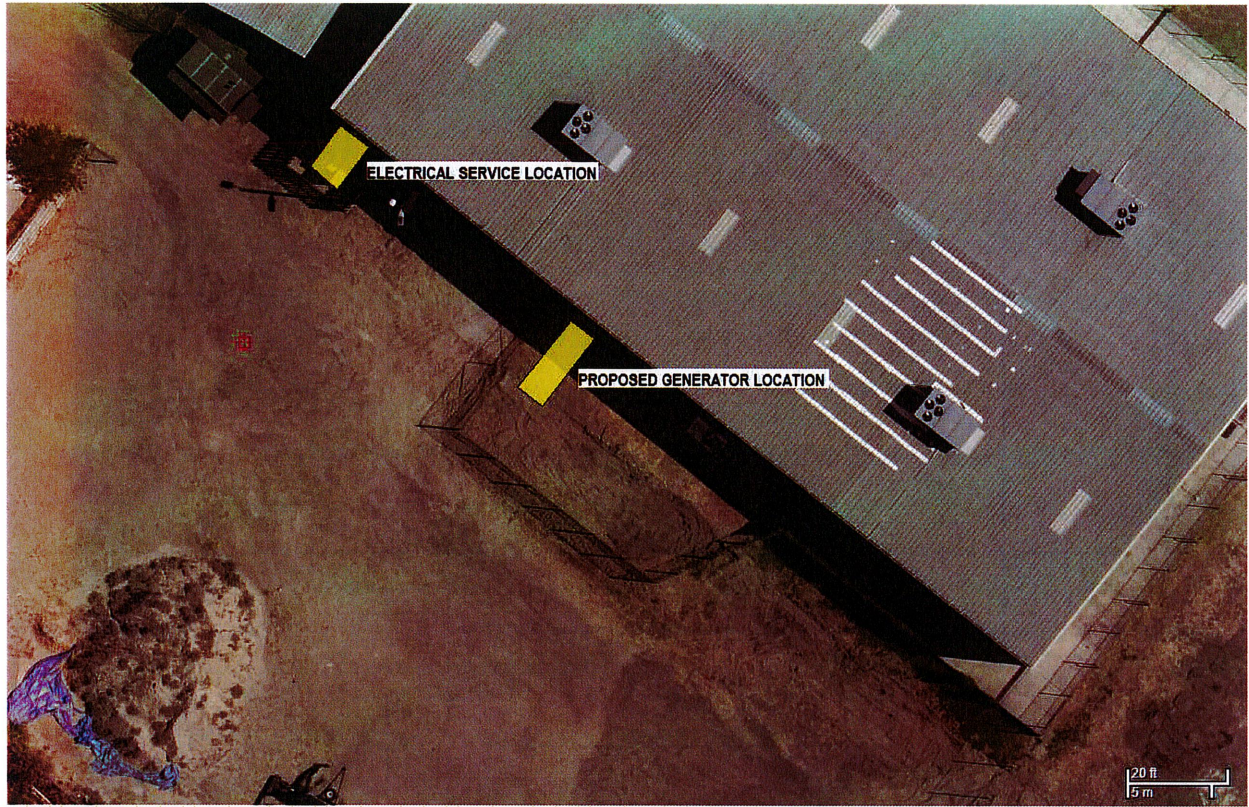
- **New Service Installation:** Furnish and install a new electrical service with an automatic transfer switch (ATS) to serve as the main disconnect.
- **Conduit Installation:**
 - Install 50 ft of 4" PVC Schedule 40 conduit within the excavated trench.
 - Connect the conduit sections using PVC glue/cement.
 - Install a 3" red trench caution tape along the entire length of the trench to mark the buried electrical line.
- **Wiring:**
 - Pull and terminate 300 ft of 500 MCM THHN/THWN copper stranded wire for the main power feed.
 - Pull and terminate 75 ft of 3 AWG green XHHW copper wire for the grounding conductor.
- **Equipment Installation:**
 - Install one existing 350 kW generator on the new concrete slab.
 - Install one 400A automatic transfer switch (ATS).
 - Install two 200A, 3-phase, 600V, NEMA 3R, right-hand, fused heavy-duty safety switches.
 - Install two 200A, 1-gang, 3-phase meter sockets.

5. Final Restoration

- **Backfill:** Backfill the trench with the excavated soil, compacting the soil as required.
- **Soil Restoration:** Reinstall the staged 102 sq ft of soil over the backfilled trench and any other disturbed areas.

6. Testing and Commissioning

- Upon completion of all electrical and mechanical installations, conduct a comprehensive test of the generator and ATS to ensure proper operation, including a transfer test from utility power to generator power and back.
