

**SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS
AND
FRANCISCO QUEVEDOS**

Article I

This Settlement Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the WEBB County Sheriff's Office, Webb County, Texas (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "County") and Francisco Quevedos (hereafter referred to as the "Releasing Party"). The County and the Releasing Parties are hereafter collectively referred to as (the "Parties"). The Parties have entered into this Agreement with the aid of their respective legal counsel.

- 1.01 The Parties to this Agreement have a dispute arising from the involuntary detention/arrest of the Releasing Party, which occurred on or about August 21st, 2022.
- 1.02 The Releasing Party filed a timely request to clarify the incident referred to above.
- 1.03 The Parties have negotiated this Agreement in good faith and intend this Agreement to settle and finally dispose of all claims of Francisco Quevedos whether known or unknown at this time regarding the involuntary detention/arrest of the Releasing Party.
- 1.04 The Parties hereto, in an effort to avoid the time and cost of protracted litigation over disputed matters contained herein and in being desirous of settling the issues regarding this dispute have agreed to enter into this Agreement.

Article II

In Consideration Of the mutual promises, recitals, and agreements contained in this Agreement, including the recitals set forth above and for other good and valuable consideration

acknowledged by their signatures on this Agreement, each of the Parties named in this Agreement and his or her predecessors, successors, assigns, heirs, executors, administrators, officers, agents, and legal representatives agree as follows:

- 2.01 Releasing party will be reimbursed for legal expenses in the amount of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) in order to correct the detention record of the Releasing Party.
- 2.02 The Releasing Party shall consider this matter closed and shall release the County from any and all liability whether known or unknown to either of the Parties to this Agreement.
- 2.03 The Releasing Party shall bear the burden of completing any action needed to correct the detention/arrest that occurred on or about August 21st, ~~2024~~ 2022.

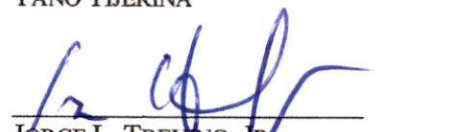
