MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Sexual Assault Services and Information (SASI) Program under the direction of Serving Children and Adults in Need, Inc. (SCAN, Inc.) and Webb County Sheriff's Office hereby consent and enter into this Memorandum of Understanding.

The SCAN, Inc. SASI Program and Webb County Sheriff's Office have a long history of collaboration including facilitating referrals for survivors of sexual and domestic violence to receive counseling services and shelter.

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to support the SCAN, Inc. SASI Program's application for funding for primary prevention programming in partnership with Webb County Sheriff's Office to further primary prevention efforts in Webb County, and to show that the program will be supported for successful implementation of program activities within the community.

Webb County Sheriff's Office agrees to:

1. Participate in, or designate a representative to, join the Community Advisory Board.
2. Collaborate in developing and implementing community activities aimed at preventing sexual violence using the Close to Home approach.
3. Provide shelter, counseling, and educational services to community participants who meet admission criteria for Webb County Sheriff's Office services.
4. Make Webb County Sheriff's Office staff aware of opportunities to participate in Close to Home community activities aimed at preventing sexual violence.
5. Maintain regular contact with the Primary Prevention Coordinator and the Community Health Coordinator to ensure successful implementation of Close to Home community activities.

The SASI Program agrees to provide the following services to all the above-mentioned parties:

1. Coordinate community activities using the Close to Home approach with community members including adolescents, young adults, and adult influencers to set in motion the growth of a community network that can co-create actions for sexual violence prevention.
2. Refer community activity participants to the Webb County Sheriff's Office if they disclose having been victimized and are in need of law enforcement services.
3. Maintain regular communication with the designated contact to ensure successful implementation of the Close to Home community activities.

Terms and conditions:

The terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall begin on the date of execution and end 2 years from that date.

This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either the mutual consent of the parties or at the option of either party to this agreement, provided such notice is put in writing and hand delivered or sent certified mail return receipt requested to the other party. The termination shall take effect seven (7) days after the party receives the written notice.

Amendment and modification:

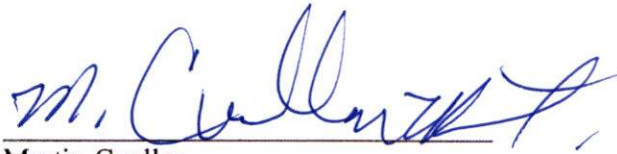
This agreement may be amended by the mutual agreement of the parties hereto in writing, to be attached and incorporated into this agreement.
