Having a quorum in place and having reviewed the documents submitted, we hereby certify that the figures on the tally sheets (Summary Results Report) correspond with the figures on the returns sheets. The figures include provisional ballots qualified and tallied under Section 65.057 (a) (2), Texas Election Code, Overseas ballots received, accepted, and tallied under Section 86.007 (d) (3), (e) & (f), Texas Election Code, as well as any Federal Write-in Absentee Ballots (FWAB) authorized by the federal Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (42 USC 1973 ff-2).

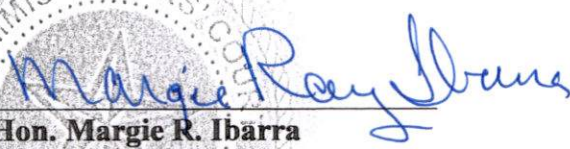

ORDER CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Texas (the "State") ordered an election to be held throughout this state, including this County on November 5, 2025, on seventeen Constitutional Amendment Propositions hereinafter stated;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of the County (the "Court") has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding, and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to the Court.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

1. The Court officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered; proper notice of said election was duly given; proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; said election was duly held; the County has complied with applicable law including the Texas Election Code; due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered; and the Court has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the State calling said election.

2. The Court officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election on the fourteen submitted Propositions by the resident, qualified electors of the County, who voted at the election:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSITION 1

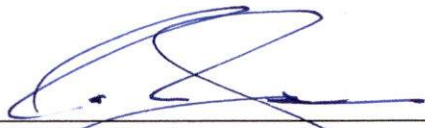

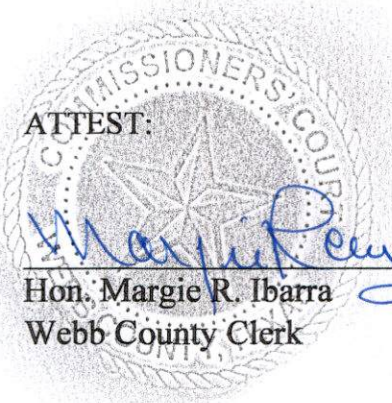
