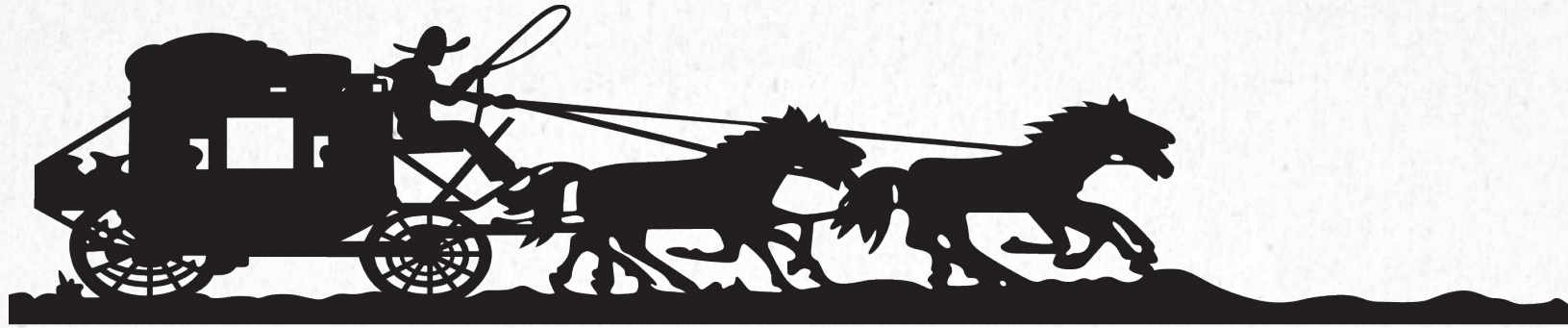
Building for the Future:
