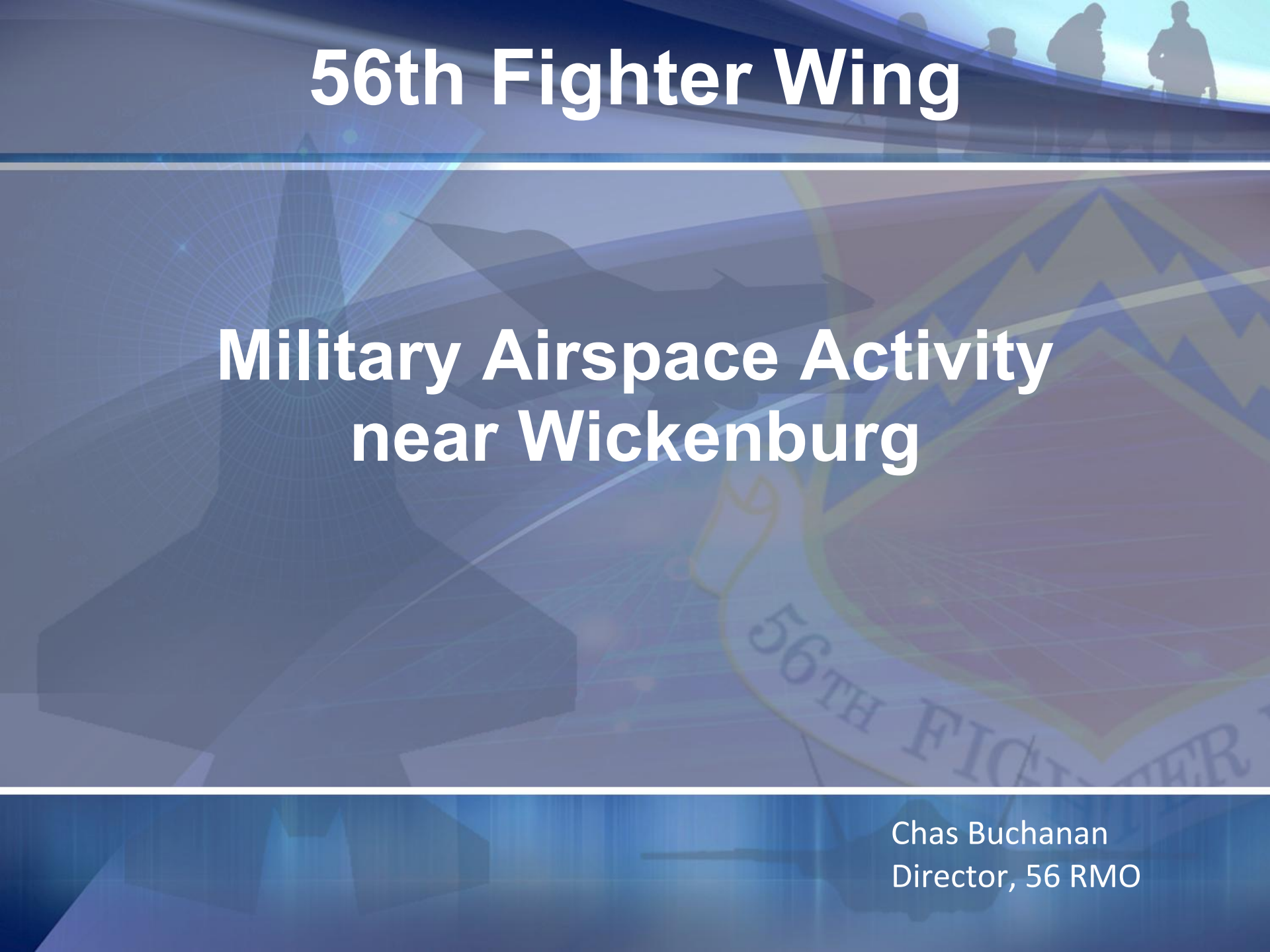

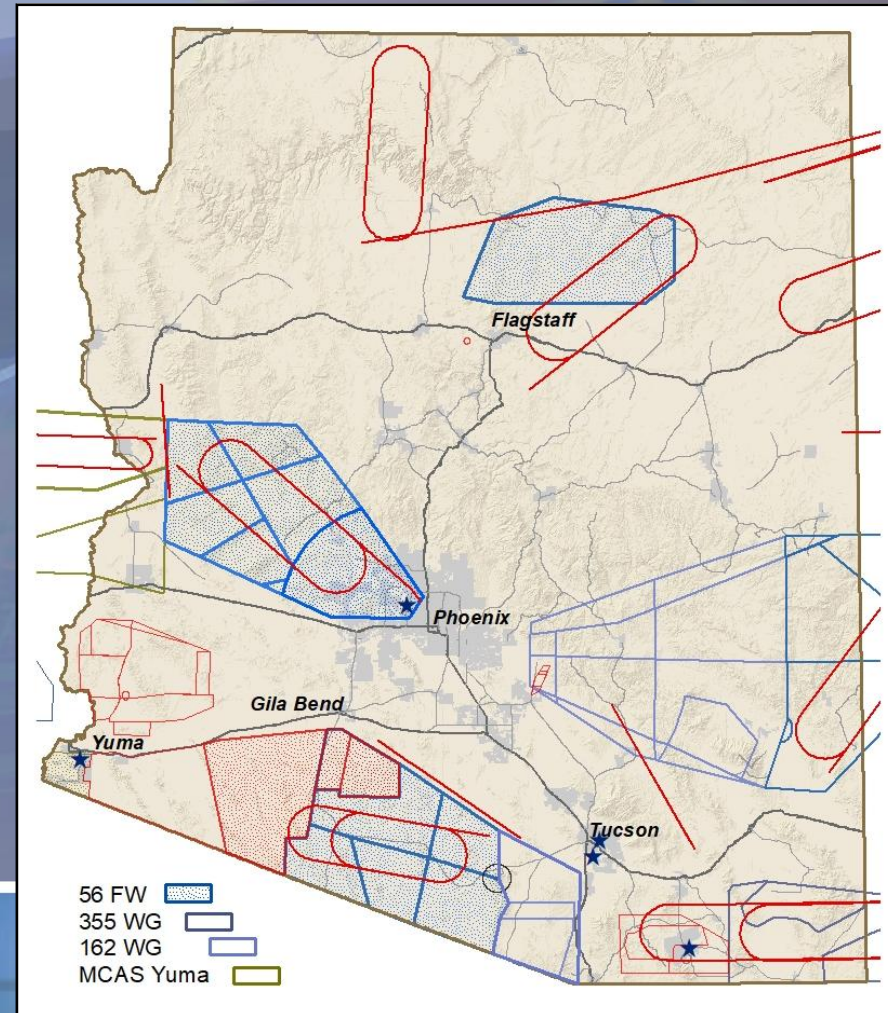

Arizona Special Use Airspace (SUA)

- Predominantly serves 3 Air Force Wings
 - 56 FW (Luke) – Glendale AZ
 - 355 WG (Davis Monthan) – Tucson
 - 162 WG (Morris ANG Base) – Tucson
- Other services' SUA
 - Yuma Proving Ground (Army)
 - MCAS Yuma (Marines)
 - Ft Huachuca (Army)
- Airspace in general
 - Supports full spectrum of training
 - Air-to-Air (all airspace)
 - Air-to-Ground (southern restricted airspace for weapons employment)

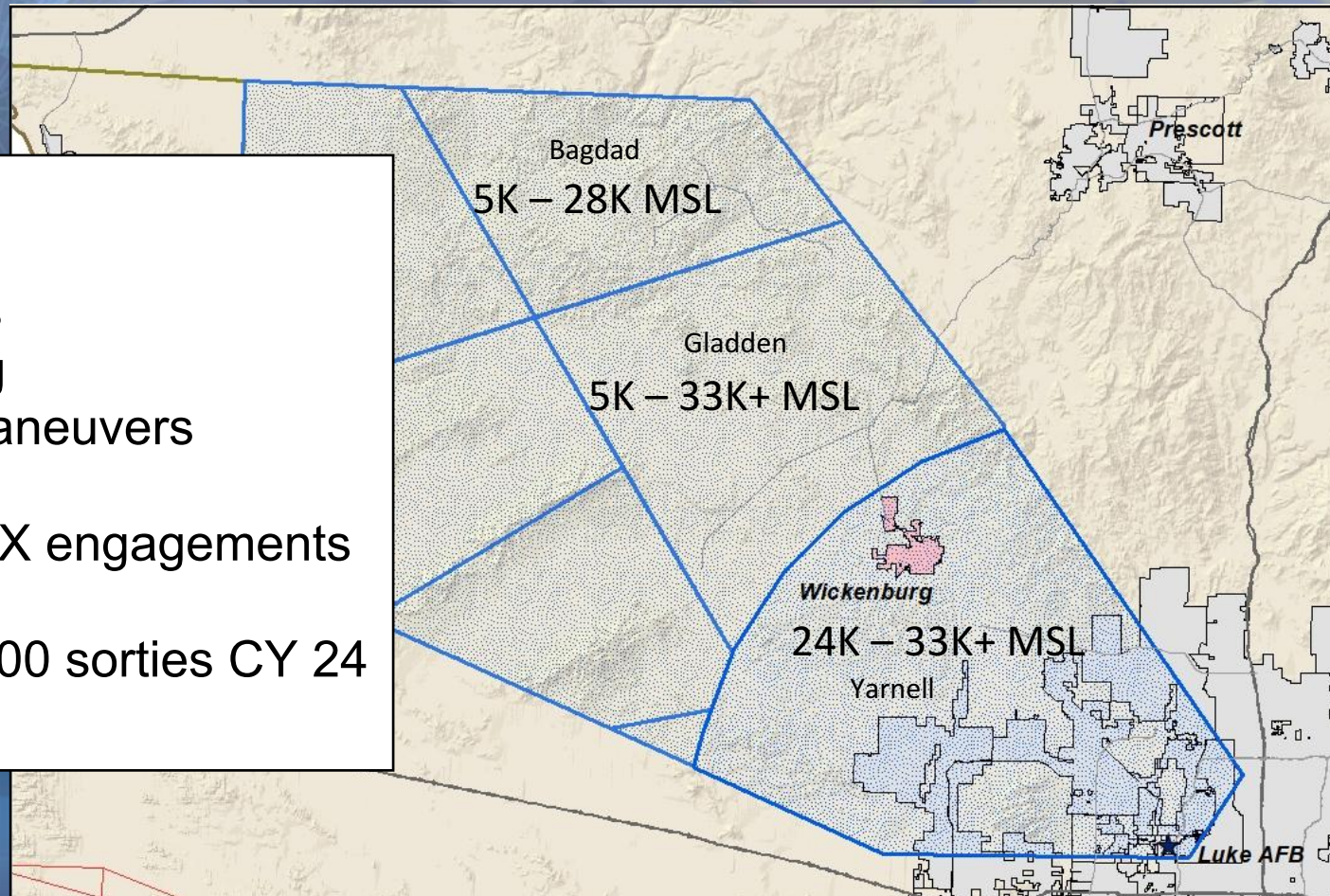

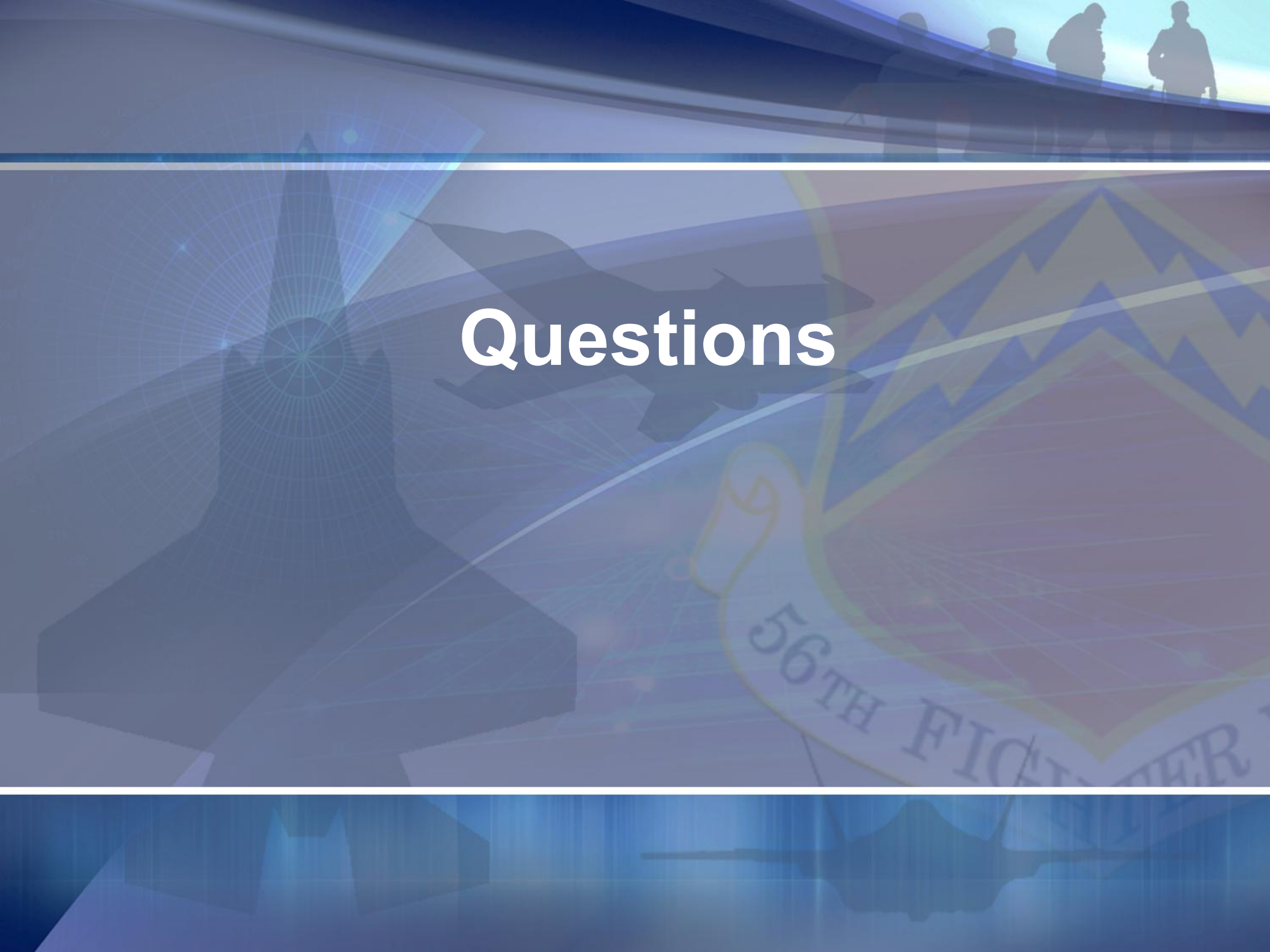
