Mary,

I sent you a letter (1/5/2009) to all 22 property owners whose property abuts CR116 explaining that we would be resubmitting the roadway, upon completion of the association. In that letter I gave six choices for residents to choose from. I was immediately contacted by a resident (Margaret Fox) and asked why the name "Robbie HSB Rd" was not included in the selection. She told me that she has lived there for as long as the road has been there and wished that it could be renamed back to that. Within three days, I had received calls from 6 additional residents asking for the same name to be included as a choice for them to vote on. I checked through the 911 records and found that "Robbie HSB Rd" was not already in use anywhere in the area, so I added that as a choice and sent a second letter/bullet (1/13/2009) to all 22 property owners. Within 2 weeks, I had received 17 responses/bulletins back from the residents. 14 bulletins listed "Robbie HSB Rd" as their 1st choice. Many of the residents were very adamant that "Robbie HSB" would be the only choice that they would agree to. I only received one bullet back that did not choose "Robbie HSB" and 7 property owners never responded to the letter. Because the majority of the property owners had already voted in favor of "Robbie HSB", I sent another letter (1/23/2009) to all 22 property owners stating that the name would be changed to "Robbie HSB". I explained the process that the name change would entail and gave dates and contact information for the residents to voice their questions and complaints regarding the process. As of today, I have not received one call or correspondence about this issue.

I did not receive a call from a woman representing Bowers Properties who was initially in opposition to the name change. After speaking with her, her opposition dealt primarily with a development that will occur on the south side of CR 111, where the street will, most likely, be named something different anyway. Because of this, I think she was indifferent to the name change on CR 116.
