Currently, in Taylor, TX, there is road construction project to expand US 79. The metal building that is to be demolished sits in this project's right_of_way (ROW). As part of Williamson County's agreement with the current owner, it has been agreed to demolish the metal building.

DESCRIPTION:

Address: 6900 CR_101, Taylor, TX 76574 (at intersection of CR_101 and US_79 between Hutto and Taylor) Approximately 50.5 feet long by 30.5 feet wide

Single story
Concrete slab
Metal Building and roof
Windows have been removed
Wood paneling interior
Suspended metal ceiling and tiles

Testing for asbestos came back negative (Does not contain asbestos per testing)

NON-MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE:

An onsite pre-bid conference will take place at 6900 CR_101, Taylor, TX (NW corner at intersection of CR_101 and US_79 between Hutto and Taylor) on **Thursday**, **November 12**, **2009 at 11:00am CST**. Though the conference is non-mandatory, <u>Williamson</u> County recommends <u>that vendors</u> attend so <u>they</u> can submit the most accurate bids possible. During this on-site conference, vendors will be able to physically inspect the building to be demolished, the surrounding land, and ask any questions in regard to this Invitation for Bid.

Terms and Conditions

You understand that you are bidding to provide building demolition and material removal services. The building and its materials and contents are in "as is" condition with no warranties or guarantees expressed or implied.

The sealed bid will be for demolition and removal of <u>all</u> of the building's materials <u>and contents</u>, and the contractor should not assume that there will be any salvageable material. The contractor will have to remove the <u>entire</u> building slab with the demolition.

The contractor is to leave alone all other property, including the business shop sign located on US 79. The contractor must not damage or remove any trees.

The current property owner is being allowed to keep building materials, such as metal siding, if he so chooses. The current property owner will have to remove these materials on his own prior to demolition beginning. The contractor <u>must</u> notify the current property owner at least 10 days prior to beginning the demolition, so that he can have the opportunity to remove any material he wants to keep. Any material that the current owner has not removed prior to demolition <u>must</u> be removed from the building site by the contractor.

The contractor must disconnect electric extension power cord running from home to metal building and confirm with property owner that all utilities have been disconnected prior to demolition.

There is a narrow 2-lane bridge (driveway) from the owner's house to CR_101, which goes over an irrigation ditch. The contractor will <u>not</u> be allowed to block access to this driveway. Furthermore, the Contractor shall not damage the 2-lane bridge by exceeding its weight capacity. In the event the Contractor does in fact damage the 2-lane bridge, the Contractor shall be liable to the current property owner for all such damages.

Williamson County reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all bids.

The winning bidder must remove the building and all of its building materials and contents within twenty (20) working days, following acceptance of bid.

The winning bidder is responsible for all <u>possible</u> insurance and maintenance requirements upon taking possession of the <u>metal building and/or its materials</u>.

The contractor will take all responsibility and pay any and <u>all permits and</u> fees, including providing or hiring labor for the movement of the demolition building and/or its materials.


