A maximum of seven (7) qualified Mental Health Professionals (QMHPs) employed by the Mobile Outreach Team may be designated as Field Training Officers. A maximum of \$100.00 per month may be paid as FTO incentive pay per employee. Field Training Officers will provide clinical education to new employees, medical students, nursing students, and interns from the fields of social work, psychology, and/or criminal justice. MOT FTOs are required to possess a thorough knowledge of current principles and practices of emergency mental health care. When supervising students, the FTO must be designated as an approved instructor by the students' accredited college or university and will abide by all agreements between the institution of higher learning and Williamson County.
