

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-1-18**

## RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CREATION OF CORN HILL REGIONAL WATER AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, City of Jarrell is a political subdivision of the State of Texas located in Williamson County;

WHEREAS, the District provides water service to its residents and businesses;

WHEREAS, the Texas Water Development Board, in connection with the District and other water utilities in northern Williamson County and southern Bell County have engaged in efforts to plan for future water supplies for the area;

WHEREAS, the regional plan has identified the need for future water supplies to be transported to the area;

WHEREAS, those future supplies will require cooperation among the District and other water utilities serving the area;

WHEREAS, creation of a regional water authority to cooperate with the water utilities serving the water needs of the planning area in order to facilitate the financing and implementation of future regional water supplies for the planning is prudent and appropriate;

WHEREAS, the District is of the opinion that creation of the proposed Corn Hill Regional Water Authority (the "Authority") by the Texas Legislature to serve as the regional water provider to facilitate the implementation of a future supply of water for the water providers in the regional planning area who desire to become members of the Authority would be a benefit to the District and the regional planning area;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JARRELL that the City supports and requests creation of the Corn Hill Regional Water Authority by the Texas Legislature.
