As you know, Williamson County and the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority ("CTRMA") executed an Interlocal Agreement ("ILA") on or about the 12th day of April, 2011 whereby said parties agreed that CTRMA would assume all obligations and responsibilities of Williamson County under the Advanced Funding Agreement for a Transportation Enhancement Project ("AFA"). In assuming all obligations of the County and complying with all terms and conditions under the AFA, CTRMA agreed, among other obligations, to serve as Project Manager on behalf of County and CTRMA, administer all aspects of design and construction for Project, including preparation of construction plans, competitive bidding, construction and inspection of the Project.

CTRMA has now completed a bid and procurement process for the selection of a construction contractor to construct the Project and has selected the lowest, responsive bidder, Montoya Anderson Construction (MAC), Inc. Williamson County has concurred in the CTRMA's selection and is now requesting TxDOT's concurrence on a decision to award the 183A South Brushy Creek Pedestrian Bridge contract to the lowest, responsive bidder, Montoya Anderson Construction (MAC), Inc.
