A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF VIOLENT CRIMES AGAINST WOMEN CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND TRAINING PROJECTS – DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, SEXUAL ASSAULT, DATING VIOLENCE, AND STALKING PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR A VICTIMS' ASSISTANT COORDINATOR FOR THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION GRANT.

WHEREAS, the District Attorney's Office of Williamson County desires to develop the Williamson County Coordinated Prosecution Services for Female Victims of Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault to respond immediately to assist and educate victims of domestic violence and other violent crimes; and

WHEREAS, responding to the emotional, physical and safety needs of victims at an early stage, will deter from posing any further threat to said victims and to the citizens of Williamson County; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, Williamson County assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County designates the County Judge as the grantee's authorized official and is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Williamson County to apply for funding under the Violent Crimes Against Women Criminal Justice and Training Projects – Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault, Dating Violence, and Stalking Program Request for FY 2013 Grant Cycle:
