Overview: Juvenile Services is willing to manage the Justice Court Case-Manager for Precinct #3. The Code of Criminal Procedures Article 45.056 authorizes the justice court of a county to assess a \$5.00 fee on all cases to be used to employ a juvenile case-manager upon approval from commissioner's court. September 20, 2011 Williamson County Commissioner's Court approved collection of the fee to employ a part-time juvenile case manager in Precinct #3. The part-time juvenile case-manager in Precinct #3 will be utilized to supervise Failure to Attend School cases and diversion programs as outlined in Senate Bill 61. Williamson County Juvenile Services will hire, train, house and provide supervision for the juvenile case-manager consistent with CCP Article 45.056 (1). The Auditor's Office has placed the fees collected by Precinct #3 in a separate fund and below is the expenditure budget which will be managed by Juvenile Services to pay the salary and benefits of the juvenile case manager pursuant to Article 102.0174 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, Chapter 45.

The position will work 10 hours per week at \$15.00 per hour.
