## Change Order No. 27

### **Reason for Change**

This Change Order provides compensation to the Contractor to modify the cross slope of the pedestrian crosswalk at the intersection of Wildwood and Williams Drive to meet ADA requirements. This work includes removing and replacing the asphalt surface to change the cross slope of the cross walk and removing & replacing the pedestrian ramps to match the new pavement slopes. In addition, this Change Order adds new Contract items for TxDOT requested modifications to the small signs on FM 3405.


Following is a summary of new item required for this Change Order:

As a result of this and all Change Orders to date, \$2,170,650.55 has been added to the Contract resulting in an 18.9% net increase in the Contract Cost. No additional days will be added to or deducted from the Contract as a result of this Change Order.


