## **RESOLUTION**

***WHEREAS***, Anisa Wakil , age 17, a member of Girl Scout Troop 1667 of Central Texas, Springwoods Service Unit , and also a Senior at Vista Ridge High School, Cedar Park, Texas; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa is involved in Band, serving as Drum Major and Vice President for Vista Ridge Marching Band, who is also a 5A All State Flute player and Outstanding Soloist at Texas State Solo and Ensemble; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa attended summer leadership camps for Drum Majors during the summer of 2011 and 2012; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa is a member of the Austin Youth Orchestra, Rattan Creek Hurricanes Swim Club, National Honor Society, and Rangers Above Destructive Decisions ; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa plans to attend Texas A&M University, Rice, or SMU upon graduation from High School; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa joined Girl Scouts of Central Texas in Kindergarten in the fall of 2001 and has served in Scouting for 13 years; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa previously earned the Girl Scout Bronze Award – Project Linus and the Silver Award-Stockings for Soldiers; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa has successfully completed all of the necessary requirements of her Girl Scout Gold Award Service Project entitled Williamson County Parks & Recreation Headquarters Beautification; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa consulted with Landscape Professionals, Park Professionals, and Master Naturalists to landscape the new Parks Department Headquarters building located at the Southwest Williamson County Regional Park, Leander, Texas; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa provided a visual example of drought tolerant, deer resistant, fire defensible landscaping that others could emulate on their personal property to help with water conservation, erosion control, wildfire defense, and beautification; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa inscribed the name of each plant in rock, and created a brochure describing each plant; and

***WHEREAS***, Anisa constructed a stone pathway across the Headquarters lawn to help focus foot traffic and conserve native plant life; and
