Your Honor, it is my duty and my pleasure to report to you that the Wilco VOAD Long Term Recovery Committee established in October of 2010 to address the losses inflicted upon the residents of this county by Tropical Storm Hermine has been formally dissolved as of 18 Oct., 2012. This disaster affected 630 families in our county and Williamson County received 43 applications for assistance. The LTRC, in cooperation with other governmental and non-profit organizations, helped coordinate services and repairs for these homes and homeowners. There were nine (9) residents with limited or no other personal resources to rebuild that has moderate to extensive repair and restoration needed for their homes. The LTRC is happy to report that funds were raised, volunteers recruited and repairs made on these homes. All nine (9) residents are in their homes as of this time. This work could not have been accomplished without the extraordinary efforts of people like Bill Banbrick and Elizabeth Leyva, nonprofits such as Drops of Grace and Adults in Mission from the First United Methodist Church in Round Rock and corporate partners like Chasco Construction. We would like to show our appreciation for their work by presenting these gifts to them. There were thousands of volunteer hours given by hundreds of different volunteers who came from a variety of companies, churches, non-profit and benevolent organizations both within and from outside of our community. People who mucked mud out of homes, loaded haul off containers with ruined possessions and just sat and held hands or listened to those devastated by this event. There were those who painted and hung gypsum wall board, people who stretched carpet and hung wall paper, those who rewired and set cabinets or hammered nails and set tile. We owe our success to each and every volunteer and donor and on behalf of those who suffered through this time, we offer out thanks and our gratitude. Thank you for your time and the Court's time today.
