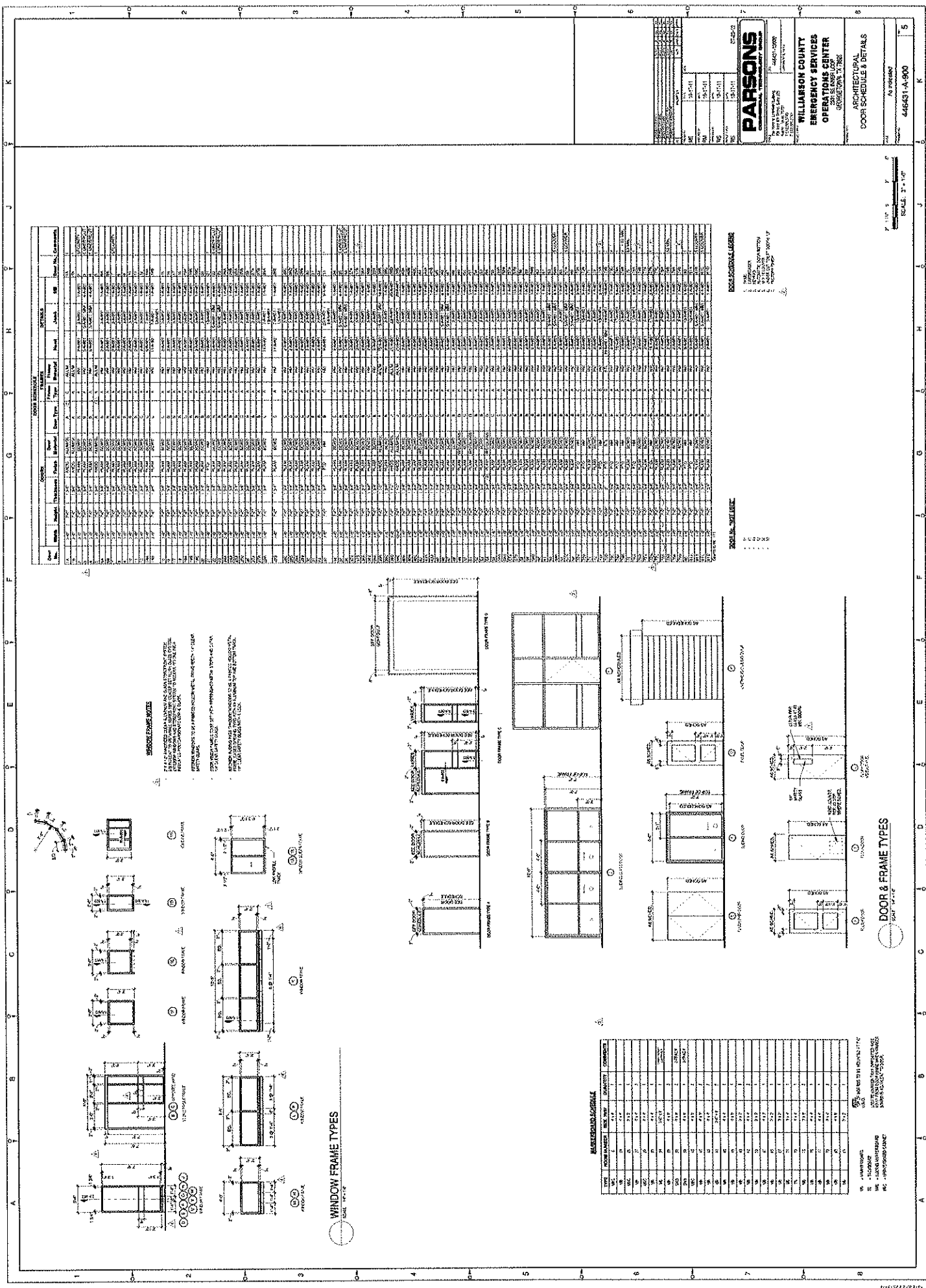


2 CLOSETORY WINDOWS AT EXERCISE ROOM
