After reviewing the bids and doing some comparison of the specification sheet on the 2 different monitors that were bid, I am suggesting that we purchase the MiniRae3000 from FarrWest. Below is my justification.

First, the reason I chose the MiniRae 3000 over the Ion Science Tiger:

MiniRae – US and Canada UL listing for Division 1 class 1, intrinsically safe for operation in a flammable atmosphere

Ion Science – only intrinsically safe by European approval

MiniRae – IP67 rated for decontamination after use when turned off, IP65 rating while running Ion Science – Only IP65 rated for heavy rain

MiniRae –Bluetooth capable for wireless communication that can hook into our current system for monitoring

Ion Science – Wireless Communication is coming in the Future

MiniRae – Compatible with our current charging and calibration systems Ion Science – Not compatible

Now for the vendor:

Looking at the 2 vendors that offered the MiniRae 3000, FarrWest was approx. \$700 cheaper for the 2 units and that included the 3 days of onsite training. GeoTech had an additional charge for the onsite training.
