Re: Sole Source recommendation for Norex, Inc.

Dear County Judge and Commissioners,

Recently our county IT Department made a request for qualifying the sole source membership renewal for Norex, Inc. Norex is a knowledge sharing consortium of Information Systems and Information Technology Departments that facilitates sharing between various groups. Their service is vendor free, unbiased information that is not available from any other company.

After reviewing all documentation requested and submitted, I recommend qualifying this request as a sole source purchase per Texas Local Government Code sections 262.003 (a) and 262.024 (a) (7).

The process has included the following:

- Public posting of an RFI in BidSync for 14 days, with no responses received from any other competitor, requiring additional analysis or consideration
- A signed Sole Source Justification Request submitted by Jay Shade, IT Director
- A signed letter of justification from the supplier, establishing why they their product / service is only available from their company
- A notarized Sole Source Affidavit completed by the supplier
- A signed letter of recommendation from Jay Shade, IT Director
- A quote for the services membership in the amount of \$5190.

The term of this Sole Source exemption will be effective from the date of approval until 5/31/2017.

I have looked at two other entities. One is Info-Tech which offers some peer-to-peer networking as part of their overall product which includes technical research. The cost for that service was over \$20,000. The second is a service we are members of Gartner which is primarily a research and consulting organization and they are attempting to add some peer-to-peer networking but it is much more limited at this time than Norex, and is much more expensive (\$50,000). I am not planning on renewing our membership with Gartner when the current year is completed.
List any other sources, suppliers, products or service providers that you reviewed in your selection process:
Info-Tech and Gartner. Both of these companies offer much more than simple peer-to-peer networking and both are significantly more expensive than Norex.
