

Acknowledgement of Transfer of Tax Roll and Delivery of Receipt between Outgoing Tax Assessor-Collector & Successor Tax Assessor-Collector


Whereas, Texas Local Government Code 112.034 mandates on leaving office the outgoing tax assessor-collector ("Outgoing Collector") shall deliver the tax rolls in that officer's possession to the successor officer ("Successor Collector"). Additionally, the Successor Collector is required to give to the Outgoing Collector a written receipt for the amount of taxes owed on those rolls, specifying the amount of each fund and each year separately and also indicating the amount due on the indigent and delinquent taxpayer lists.

Therefore, on this the 31st day of December 2016, the Williamson County Tax-Assessor Collector, also referred herein as Outgoing Collector, hereby delivers all tax rolls in her possession to the Successor Collector, who was elected on March 1, 2016, and is expected to take office on January 2, 2017.

Successor Collector, by signature below, acknowledges delivery of tax rolls and hereby issues the attached receipts labeled "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference, to Outgoing Collector which specifies the amount of each fund and each separately, as well as the amount due on the indigent and delinquent taxpayer lists.

Outgoing Collector, by signature below, acknowledges delivery of receipts, which shall be delivered to the county clerk who shall charge the credited amounts to the Successor Collector in the proper accounts.
