Please find attached the bid tabulations for the subject-referenced project. The bids have been reviewed and none of the bids had to be adjusted for correctness. The bids are therefore accepted with Jordan Foster Construction being the low bidder. Following is a summary of the bid totals:

The Contractor's low bid is \$66,200.00 below the Engineer's Estimate, a cost saving of 24.5%.

In addition to meeting the bid qualifications subject to being low bidder, Jordan Foster Construction has performed work on other Road Bond Program projects including RM 620 Safety Improvements, Wyoming Springs Drive and CR 175 Ph 2A. Based on the quality of work performed by the Contractor, we recommend award of the Southwest Bypass Access Route construction contract to Jordan Foster Construction in the contract amount of \$204,000.00.
