It is expressly understood that, as a condition of donation(s) made, Williamson County must use the funds to pay for Williamson County's costs associated with the above-mentioned event, which includes the costs of Williamson County Sheriff's Office overtime, Williamson County Emergency Manager's overtime, Williamson County Command Vehicle 3 and Williamson County Sheriff's Office patrol cars. **Tex. Atty Gen. No. GA-0562, 12-13 (2007) (discussing common law of gifts and concluding that a commissioners court may accept "funds that were donated on condition that they be used [a certain way not contrary to the Texas Constitution] ... but [if] [the court] uses the funds for an inconsistent purpose, the commissioners court risks revocation of the donated funds.").**

The gift you are making is for the benefit of the taxpayers of Williamson County, Texas and shall be deposited into Williamson County's general revenue fund to be used to pay the costs

identified herein.
