DEFAULT JUDGMENT

On this day, the Court considered the above entitled and numbered cause of action wherein The State of Texas is Petitioner and Julio Chavez-Lepe is the Respondent. The property made the subject of this cause of action is described in Petitioner's Notice of Seizure and Intended Forfeiture.

Petitioner appeared by and through her attorney of record and announced ready for trial. Respondent, Julio Chavez-Lepe, although duly served with Citation and the Petitioner's Notice of Seizure and Intended Forfeiture in the manner prescribed by law, failed to appear or answer in this Cause and has wholly made default. The Citation, with the officer's return, has been on file with the Clerk of the Court ten (10) days exclusive of the date of filing and the date of judgment.

The Court finds that Petitioner has produced evidence sufficient to show that the property made the subject of this suit is contraband and is subject to forfeiture under the provisions of Chapter 59, Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the sum of Eight Hundred Thirty-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$834.00), plus interest from the date of deposit in an interest-bearing account, is forfeited to the State of Texas to be administered by the Williamson County District Attorney, pursuant to the applicable local agreements in the manner prescribed by Article 59.06, Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the 2013 Nissan X-Trail [REDACTED] is forfeited to the State of Texas, to be administered by the Williamson County District Attorney, pursuant to the applicable local agreements with the Williamson County Sheriff's Office, in a manner prescribed by Article 59.06, Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, and that upon payment of all lawful liens The State of Texas shall issue a title to said vehicle free and clear of all liens to the Williamson County Sheriff's Office.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any property that is held as evidence in any pending civil forfeiture or criminal case and ordered distributed in this judgment, shall not be distributed until such criminal or civil forfeiture case is final and/or the evidence hold removed.

All costs of Court are taxed against Julio Chavez-Lepe, Respondent, for which let execution issue if not timely paid.


