

**A Resolution of the Williamson County Commissioners' Court
Approving the Williamson County Project Applications to
Be Submitted to the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning
Organization for the Fiscal Year 2019-2022 Project Call
for Project Funding**

WHEREAS, the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) has announced a project call for Fiscal Year 2019-2022 for project funding from a variety of funding sources; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2013, voters in Williamson County approved a \$275 million road bond program of critically-needed mobility and safety improvements both on and off the State Highway System; and

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioner's Court approved and adopted the Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and subsequent amendments and approved specific funding for development of corridors identified in the LRTP in both the FY 2017 the FY 2018 budgets; and

WHEREAS, the following elements of the Williamson County LRTP and 2013 bond program have been identified as being competitive for the CAMPO Fiscal Year 2019-2022 Project Call:

- Corridor C from Sam Houston at Patriot Way to SH 29
- Southeast Corridor Study
 - Corridor A-1 - East/west connector between SH 130 and FM 3349
 - Corridor A-2 – East/west connector between FM 3349 and SH 95
 - Corridor E-1- North/south connector between Corridor A and US 79;
- RM 2243 from 183A to SH 29;
- SH 29E from SH 130 to SH 95;
- University Boulevard Expansion from FM 1460 to SH 130; and
- IH-35 Southbound Frontage Road (CSJ# 0015-09-187) from RM 2243 to RM 1431.

WHEREAS, the award of CAMPO funding for these projects could allow approved bond or LRTP funding to initiate project development for other projects included in the LRTP or to accelerate construction;

WHEREAS, if a project listed above is selected, Williamson County is committed to contributing the local funding match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Williamson County Commissioners' Court:

- (a) That the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County does hereby approve submitting project applications to the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Fiscal Year 2019-2022 Project Call
