

IN THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County, that the Incident Command Vehicle Project be operated for the fiscal year 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the Williamson County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners Court designates the Honorable Dan A. Gattis, Williamson County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Williamson County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the Incident Command Vehicle Project to the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Division.
