## **APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED FOR HISTORICAL COMMISSION MEMBERS**

May XX, 2018 (Williamson County, TX) – Williamson County currently has openings for membership in the Williamson County Historical Commission (WCHC). The WCHC is designated to coordinate and supervise historic preservation under the direction of the Williamson County Commissioners Court. The purpose of the WCHC is to preserve, protect, and promote history within the county.

The WCHC is composed of at least seven Williamson County residents who have demonstrated an interest in the preservation of Williamson County's historical heritage and preferably live in Williamson County. Individuals wishing to serve on the WCHC should fill out an application and submit it to their Williamson County precinct commissioner or the county judge. Voting members must be 18 years of age or older.
