AUGUST 2018 IN REVIEW

8/3/2018: Smith Contracting filled the ditch between the retaining walls with rock riprap. The west driveway to Holy Family School was poured. Flexible base was placed for the north shared use path (SUP) in front of Holy Family School.

8/10/2018: The east driveway to the Holy Family School was poured. Concrete was placed for the north SUP in front of Holy Family School and flexible base placed in front of Savio High School. Subcontractors Avery Lawn Care installed tree protection and subcontractor ESSI installed metal beam guard fence.

8/17/2018: Concrete placement continued for the north side SUP in front of Holy Family School. Concrete placement was completed for the MBGF mowstrip. Roadway and SUP excavation began for Phase IV between Olive Hill Way and Altona Way on the south side of the project.

8/24/2018: Concrete placement for the north SUP continued in front of Savio High School. Other north side SUP concrete placement was completed.

8/31/2018: Roadway and SUP excavation continued for Phase IV between Altona Way and Solera Dr. on the south side of the project. Topsoil was placed in all ponds. The installation of the pedestrian hand rail began along Wall P.
