Re: Sole Source recommendation for OPEX Corporation

Dear County Judge and Commissioners,

Recently our Tax Assessor/Collector Office made a renewal request for an existing contract with OPEX Corporation. These actions require new qualification as a sole source provider of warranty and maintenance for existing hardware for the AS7200 scanner utilized to scan large amount of documents. These services are supplied only by OPEX Corporation who is the owner, and the only provider of this proprietary service diagnostic hardware and software.

After reviewing all documentation requested and submitted, I recommend qualifying this request as a sole source purchase and exempting these goods from competitive bidding requirements per Texas Local Government Code sections 262.003 (a) and 262.024 (a) (7),

The process has included the following:

- Public posting of an RFI in BidSync for 14 days, with zero (0) responses received from another competitor.
- A signed Sole Source Justification Request from Larry Gaddes, Tax Assessor/Collector
- A signed letter of justification from the supplier, establishing why their product / service is only available from their company
- A notarized Sole Source Affidavit completed by the supplier
- · A price quote of requested items/services and amendment

The term of this Sole Source exemption will be effective for 36 months from the date of approval.

Sole Source Justification Request

Definition of a Sole Source Purchase

Sole Source Item – goods and/or services which can only be obtained from ONLY ONE source, including:

- Items for which competition is precluded because of the existence of patents, copyrights, secret processes, or monopolies
- Films, manuscripts, or books
- Electric power, gas, water, and other utility services.
- Captive replacement parts or components for equipment which there is no commercially available substitute, and which can be obtained only from the manufacturer and/or manufacturer's distributor; item where compatibility is the overriding consideration, such as computer operating software enhancements for an existing system, continuation of an existing contract when work is so closely related to that of the uncompleted basic contract that it would not be feasible to consider another potential contractor.

This Sole Source justification requires additional documentation and requirements as listed below. The sole source term is generally aligned with the contract term. In certain cases, the Purchasing Agent may determine that the 14-day public posting in BidSync is not necessary. This depends on the circumstance of the particular item/service and the type of sole source.

If you are seeking to have a single entity provide parts and service for both your OPEX® AS7200and your OMATION® 206, please note that OPEX Corporation ("OPEX"), the sole manufacturer of such equipment, is also the sole source authorized to provide such parts and service.

Additionally, the OPEX AS7200 machines utilize proprietary service diagnostic software covered by various patents and copyrights. OPEX has not released or licensed this software to third parties. To effectively support OPEX equipment, these third parties would have to develop their own diagnostic software.

OPEX's National Service Organization is the largest and most comprehensive service organization in the industry. All of our technicians are trained at the Home Office and are directly employed by OPEX. They have undergone rigorous training in the field, and receive continuing product education on a routine basis.

Additionally, OPEX has found that third party service organizations do no perform the rigorous schedule of preventive maintenance that OPEX performs. OPEX regularly inspects your equipment at your site, and will replace all necessary parts due to normal wear and tear on the machine.
