- 4. Data raceway stubbed to accessible ceilings
- 5. Data sleeves to penetrate fire wall.
- 6. Flexible conduit to route through existing space.
- 7. Fire caulking
- 8. Demo of existing wall connecting new 911 training center to existing area.
- 9. Badging and security.
- 10. Pull strings in all empty conduits.
