Re: 2006 Road Bond Budget Adjustments

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The County recently received the final reimbursement payment for SH 195 right-of-way and utilities from TxDOT. The County's SH 195 effort was funded with FY 2006 Road Bond funds. Also, all of the 2006 Road Bond projects are now closed.

Please close the 2006 Road Bond program and make the following budget adjustments to the 2013 Road Bond budgets:

- Close P264 – RM 620/Rail Road Bridge and move \$2,000,891.07 to P235 RM 620 Phase 2
- Move \$800,892.21 from P156 - 2006 Unallocated to P235 RM 620 Phase 2
- Move \$43,877.86 from P156 - 2006 Unallocated to P243 SW Bypass/SH 29 Bypass/Inner Loop
- Close P149 SH 195 ROW and move \$796,266.87 to P453 SW Bypass/Inner Loop Phase I
- Close P156 - 2006 Unallocated and move \$2,117,410.94 to P453 SW Bypass/Inner Loop Phase I
