#### **QUARTERLY INSPECTION**

During each of (3) Quarterly Inspections, all generator systems are visually checked for potential problems, and are physically tested to assure reliability. The proper personnel will be notified of any discrepancies and advised as to the cost of repairs. No parts, supplies or annual services are included in the quarterly inspection costs.

At this time, basic run tests are conducted to ensure generator reliability and operation. An Automatic Transfer Switch visual inspection is performed annually along with transfer test, if transfer test is permitted.

EMERGENCY SERVICE RATES: All PMA customers receive priority status. Emergency service required between regular inspections will be provided at standard rates or overtime rates for labor and travel, plus current prices for materials, and mileage.

SERVICES: Servicing Agent shall provide regularly scheduled inspections and annual service on the equipment located at Site Address. Such services shall include but not be limited to quarterly and annual service. Servicing Agent shall provide such services during its regular business hours, which are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday except Holidays.

WARRANTIES: Servicing Agent warrants that service performed under this Agreement will be performed only by Servicing Agent employees who have been properly trained for the maintenance of equipment. Servicing Agent warrants that any products or parts provided by Servicing Agent will be free from defects, under normal use and operation, for a period of ninety (90) days after their date of installation. During this time, Servicing Agent shall repair such defects at Servicing Agent's expense. Defective parts replaced under this warranty shall become the property of the Servicing Agent. Parts generally considered as expendable during normal use are not covered under this warranty.

All other warranties, express and implied including merchantability and fitness for a particular use are hereby waived, disclaimed and excluded.

TERMS: Net 30 with approved credit.

<u>TAXES:</u> Unless otherwise noted, prices do not include applicable federal, state or local sales, use, property or excise taxes. In lieu of such taxes, the Owner shall provide a tax exemption certificate, acceptable to the applicable taxing authority.

EXCLUSIONS: This agreement does not include services to repair damage caused by abuse, accident, theft, acts of a third person, forces of nature or altering the equipment. At the request of the Owner, Servicing Agent will provide services at its then prevailing rate. Servicing Agent shall not be responsible for failure to render service for causes beyond its control, including strikes and labor disputes. Owner understands and agrees that Servicing Agent is not responsible for special or consequential damages, including loss of time, injury to person or property, incidental or economic loss due to unit or equipment failure. After each inspection, the Servicing Agent will furnish Owner with a written report detailing services performed, with information regarding further service needed to maintain peak performance of all systems. All permitting is excluded unless otherwise specified in this proposal.

<u>INSURANCE</u>: Upon request, Servicing Agent shall furnish Owner with certificates of insurance for all insurance coverages provided.

<u>ASSIGNMENT</u>: Neither party may assign this Agreement or any obligation or right here under without prior written consent of the other party

<u>FUEL:</u> Customer assumes responsibility for insuring adequate quantity and quality of diesel fuel required for Austin Generator Service to operate and test the generator during each service. Additional fuel testing and polishing services may be listed on this PMA or available upon request.

#### **ACCEPTANCE AND PRICING**

Prices quoted in this agreement are firm for 30 days. Prices are subject to change. Notice of price increases will be in the form of a revised Inspection Agreement and is not subject to alteration except as mutually agreed upon in writing. Periodic price increases resulting in a revised Agreement will be effective within thirty days of revision. Either party upon thirty days of written notice may terminate this Agreement at any time. Failure to notify of cancellation 30 days prior to scheduled inspection may result in a cancellation fee. Any services rendered which remain unpaid at the time of cancellation shall be due and payable upon demand.
