RESOLUTION APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN WILLIAMSON COUNTY (COUNTY) AND THE CITY OF LIBERTY HILL (CITY) FORMULATING THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COUNTY AND THE CITY FOR GRANT APPLICATION AND MANAGEMENT OF AN EMERGENCY WARNING SYSTEM PROJECT

WHEREAS; the City of Liberty Hill has anticipated applying for and receiving a FEMA Grant to construct an emergency warning system.

WHEREAS; this effort will support the Williamson County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan and will be funded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP).

WHEREAS; the Memorandum of Understanding attached to this resolution is to be considered an un-severable part of this resolution.

WHEREAS; Williamson County approves the attached Memorandum of Understanding between Williamson County and the City of Liberty Hill formulating the responsibilities of the County and the City for grant application and management of an Emergency Warning System.

WHEREAS; the person of contact for the City of Liberty Hill shall be the City's Emergency Management Planner and that signature authority is hereby granted to the Mayor of the City of Liberty Hill.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; this Resolution Approves a Memorandum of Understanding between the County and the City of Liberty Hill and formulates the responsibilities of the County and the City for grant application and management of an emergency warning system.
