Training Center

Pacesetter K9 is situated on 15 acres in the Texas Hill Country, conveniently located off Hwy 29 and County Road 200 in Liberty Hill, Texas. We are only 30 minutes north of downtown Austin.



We have a 5,000 square foot training building with a separate classroom and rooms for building search and patrol work. We also utilize a 900 acre ranch that has farmland, thick wooded brush, a creek, and old houses, enabling us to create many real world scenarios.



Kennels

Our outdoor kennels are equipped with a misting system and dog houses. Each kennel measures 5x10 with concrete floors, 4 foot concrete walls, and 4 foot chain-link fence to ensure cleanliness and maximize air flow.



Dorm Facility

We have a new dorm facility for visiting officers complete with private dorm rooms, shared bathrooms, a living and dining area, kitchen, and full washer and dryer.

Narcotics Detection Canines

Pacesetter K9 LLC is licensed by the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) to maintain controlled substances for use in conducting realistic on-site drug dog and handler training. Pacesetter K9 does not utilize pseudo training aids. This allows us to conduct real life training scenarios and provide top quality canines and the best training available.

Our Narcotics Detector Dogs are hand selected to provide the most reliable and energetic working dogs on the market. Pacesetter K9 places each canine through a rigorous testing phase before purchase. Once at our facility, canines then receive consistent, professional training and quality care to make them superior Drug Dogs.

Narcotic and illicit drugs used during the training process include:

- Heroin
- Cocaine
- Marijuana
- Methamphetamine
- MDMA (Ecstasy)

We can adjust the scent list to suit your needs.



At Pacesetter K9 we train our canines to alert in either a passive response, aggressive response, or deferred response (focus trained).

Dual Narcotics Detection/ Patrol Canines

At Pacesetter K9, our Dual Purpose Narcotics Detection / Patrol Dogs are placed through a rigorous testing phase before purchase and go through the same rigorous narcotic training as our Narcotics Detection dogs however, the Dual Purpose Dogs also have advanced patrol training.

Pacesetter K9 Dual Purpose Dogs are trained with both on and off leash obedience. Each of our Dual Purpose Narcotics Detection / Patrol Dogs are trained in protection of the handler from physical threat, attack on command, release on command, and stop pursuit of a suspect on command.



The Dual Purpose Dogs are also trained to:

Re-attack if the suspect decides to continue to resist

Assist in providing security for roadside searches of multiple detained suspects

Conduct building searches for human odor

Conduct a vehicle bailout should the officer be in danger.

Our Dual Purpose Narcotics Detection / Patrol Dogs are also trained in tracking a suspect through various terrains and conditions.

Handler Training

Pacesetter K9 offers Handler Training and Certification as well as Annual Recertification for Narcotics Detector K9 Teams and Dual Narcotics / Patrol K9 Teams. During our Handler Training Courses, students get both onsite training and off-site training to provide them with real world experience before they return to their departments. We conduct numerous realistic training scenarios such as traffic stops, tracking in various terrain, vehicle and locker searches, and other necessary scenarios. The classroom portion of our Handler Training Course also includes a Legal Update Class which provides students/officers with new K9 Case Law.

Narcotic Detector Dog Course

Our Narcotic Detector Dogs Handler Course is a 2 week (80 hour) course.

During that time we cover:

- Grooming and Health

- Basic First Aid and Safety

- Legislative Updates

- Obedience and Training Scenarios

- Narcotics Detection Searches

Our Narcotics Detection Search Training includes vehicle, luggage, packages, and building searches.

Narcotic / Patrol Dual Purpose Dog Course

After completion of the 2 week Narcotic Detection Course, our Dual Purpose Dog handler course offers an extra 2 weeks (total 160 hours).

During that time we cover:

- Handler Protection

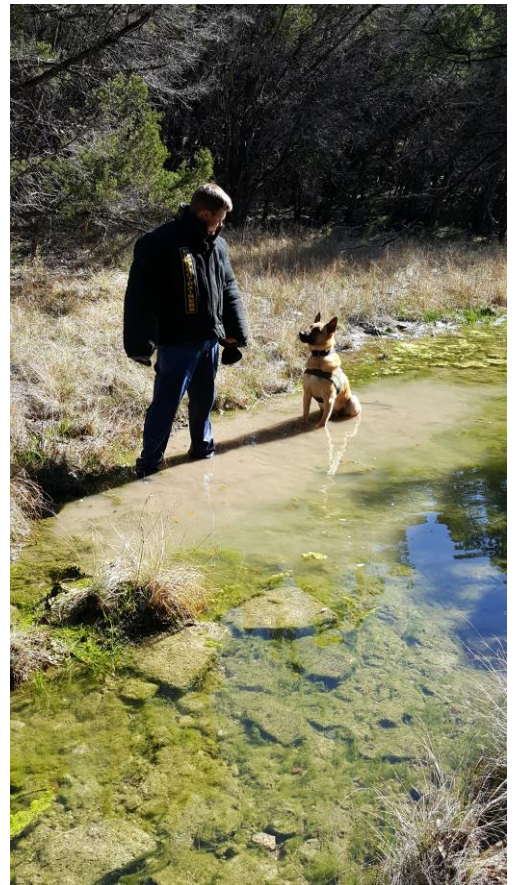

Warranties:

Pacesetter K9 will provide a copy of all health records on the canine, specifically, X-Rays (hips and elbows), blood scan, fecal, heartworm check, all current vaccinations and a Veterinary health certificate.

Pacesetter K9 will provide handler/canine proficiency training at our facility. The training will include on and off leash obedience, attack, bite, hold, out, re-attack, stay/watch, stand-off, building search, felony search, attack under gunfire, article search and tracking; detection of marijuana, heroin, cocaine, methamphetamine, and MDMA; records maintenance and courtroom testimony as well as first aid and canine maintenance.

Pacesetter K9 will re-train or replace the canine if the canine fails to preform to its specified standards with the original certified handler for a period of one year from the date of sale.

Pacesetter K9 will replace the canine if the canine manifests a genetic health defect within one year from the date of sale.
