

CV-3 was identified for replacement by Fleet Services. CV-3 was purchased with grant and cost matching in 2009. Three command vehicles were ultimately purchased to cover the CAPCOG 10-county region. Hays and Travis County were selected to own and maintain command vehicles. Funding was provided by:

- State of Texas
- CAPCOG
- CATRAC
- WCFCA

CV-3 was last upfitted with radio, audio, and visual capabilities beginning in 2018 and completed in 2019.



Discussions have begun with CAPCOG, CATRAC, and WCFCA to determine and deliver an appropriate command system that supports the current and futures needs of the county and region.

Cost effectiveness for maintenance and the ability to upgrade only needed systems are the priorities.

Input from stakeholders will drive the operational capabilities for what is needed vs what is excess and not used.
